# Reflecting on Sunday's Readings

**Introduction:** God is a God of provision. Just a few examples from Scripture will remind us how important is this truth about God. In creation God provided all that man needed in the Garden of Eden, food, animals, purpose, and even a companion to remove Adam's loneliness, and to share in God's calling. When Israel was led from Egypt to the promised-land, God provided guidance by day and by night, and food (manna and quail) and water to sustain them in the desert. Jesus continued to demonstrate that God is the God of provision by supplying wine at the wedding of Cana, feeding the thousands who came to hear him, and by instituting the Eucharist meal. So it is not unreasonable to expect that God would continue to provide for the needs of his people after Jesus' ascension. This provision is the Holy Spirit and comes through his power.

Unfortunately, most of us view the Holy Spirit as a concept and doctrinal tenet to which we profess belief, rather than an active power and presence in our life, upon which we can rely. Almost without exception the more than 95 references to the Holy Spirit in the New Testament speak of his doing some action for us. He was given to seal, sanctify, comfort, teach, guide, gift, empower, and send us. He is always an active presence. Equally interesting is the fact that our relationship to the Holy Spirit is dependent upon our actions as well. Consequently, we see in the New Testament that we are to receive, believe, be filled with, and yield to the Holy Spirit, and cautioned not to quench, grieve, resist or lie to the Holy Spirit.

He is real and active, and there exists a dynamic interaction between each of us and the Holy Spirit that either enables him to have a growing influence in our life, or that diminishes his influence in our life. And that really is the question we should ask ourselves this Pentecost Sunday, **"Am I more in tune with and yielding to the Holy Spirit's influence in my life today than I was a year ago?"**

Perhaps you're reading this and thinking, "I've really blown it. By my actions and attitudes, I have squelched his power and presence in my life." Well cheer up, that is where Christianity triumphs over man-made religion. Through the promise of confession and forgiveness the slate can be wiped clean, and you can stand justified before God (just-as-if-I'd never sinned). The Holy Spirit does not require anything else to begin the process of filling our life and fashioning it to conform to the image and character of Christ. All we need to do is to exercise those actions mentioned above, believe, receive, yield, and he will fulfill his part to, sanctify, comfort, teach, guide, gift, empower, and send us. Each day through prayer and yieldedness we can open our life to an ongoing Pentecost experience where his power and presence becomes more real and active in our life.

Origen accurately speaks of this process of renewal, "The power of God the Father and God the Son is at work in the whole of creation. The saints are those who are fully receiving life in the Holy Spirit. Accordingly, it is said, 'No man can say that Jesus is the Lord except in the Holy Spirit.'

"However unworthy the apostles might have been, they were told: 'You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit is come upon you.' This is what is referred to by the phrase, 'he who has sinned against the Son of Man is worthy of forgiveness.' Even if one at times ceases to live according to this divine word, even if one falls into ignorance or folly, the way is not blocked to true penitence and forgiveness. ..." (From the *Ancient Christian Commentary on Scripture, Vol. II*)

# Reflexionemos Sobre las lecturas del domingo

**Introducción:** Dios es un Dios proveedor. Sólo unos pocos ejemplos de la Escritura nos recordarán cuán importante es esta verdad acerca de Dios. En la Creación, Dios le proporcionó al hombre todo lo que necesitaba en el Jardín del Edén, comida, animales, propósito, e incluso una compañera para eliminar la soledad de Adán y para que tuviera con quién compartir el llamado de Dios. Cuando el pueblo de Israel fue llevado desde Egipto hasta la tierra prometida, Dios le dio guía de día y de noche, alimentos (maná y codornices) y agua para sostenerlo en el desierto. Jesús continuó demostrando que Dios es el Dios proveedor, que suministra vino en las bodas de Caná, que alimenta a los miles que acuden a escucharlo y que instituye la cena eucarística. Así que no sería ilógico esperar que, después de la Ascensión de Jesús, Dios continuaría proporcionándole a su pueblo lo necesario. Esto se concreta en el Espíritu Santo, y viene a través de su poder.

Lamentablemente, la mayoría de nosotros ve al Espíritu Santo como un concepto y un principio doctrinal en el cual profesamos creencia, en lugar de considerarlo un poder y una presencia activos en la propia vida y dignos de confianza. Casi sin excepción, en las referencias al Espíritu Santo, que superan 95 en el Nuevo Testamento, se menciona alguna acción que él hizo por nosotros. Él fue dado para sellar, santificar, consolar, enseñar, guiar, otorgar, dar poder y enviarnos. Él es siempre una presencia activa. Igualmente, interesante es el hecho de que nuestra relación con el Espíritu Santo también depende de nuestras acciones. Por consiguiente, vemos en el Nuevo Testamento que debemos recibir al Espíritu Santo, creer en él, ser llenos de él y rendirnos a él, así como también se nos advierte que debemos evitar apagar, afligir, resistirnos o mentirle al Espíritu Santo.

Él es real y activo, y existe una interacción dinámica entre cada uno de nosotros y el Espíritu Santo que le permite tener una influencia creciente en nuestra vida o disminuir su influencia en nuestra vida. Y esa es realmente

la pregunta que debemos hacernos este domingo de Pentecostés: “¿Estoy hoy más en sintonía con el Espíritu Santo y cediendo más a su influencia en mi vida que hace un año?”

Tal vez el lector esté pensando: “Realmente, he echado a perder todo. Con mis acciones y actitudes he aplastado su poder y su presencia en mi vida”. Bueno, ¡hay que animarse! Aquí es donde el cristianismo triunfa sobre la religión fabricada por el hombre. A través de la promesa de confesión y perdón, se puede tener un nuevo comienzo y estar justificado ante Dios (como si nunca se hubiera pecado). El Espíritu Santo no requiere nada más para comenzar el proceso de llenar nuestra vida y moldearla para que se ajuste a la imagen y al carácter de Cristo. Lo único que debemos hacer es ejercitar las acciones mencionadas anteriormente, creer, recibir, ceder, y él cumplirá con su parte para santificar, consolar, enseñar, guiar, dar, empoderar y enviarnos. Cada día, a través de la oración y de la entrega, podemos abrir nuestra vida a una experiencia continua de Pentecostés donde su poder y su presencia se haga más real y activa en nuestra vida.

El teólogo cristiano Orígenes habla con precisión de este proceso de renovación: “El poder de Dios Padre y de Dios Hijo actúa en toda la Creación. Los santos son aquellos que están recibiendo plenamente la vida en el Espíritu Santo. Por consiguiente, se dice: **“Nadie puede decir que Jesús es el Señor si no es en el Espíritu Santo”**.”

“Por indignos que los apóstoles pudieran haber sido, se les dijo: ‘Recibirán poder cuando el Espíritu Santo venga sobre ustedes’. A esto se refiere la frase: ‘El que ha pecado contra el Hijo del Hombre es digno de perdón’. Aunque a veces se deje de vivir según esta palabra divina, aunque se caiga en la ignorancia o en la locura, el camino no está bloqueado a la verdadera penitencia y al perdón. ...” (*Del Antiguo Comentario Cristiano sobre las Escrituras, Vol. II, Marcos, página 44*)


