


NUESTRA MISIÓN

On January 1st, Fr Mike Schmitz will begin his reading of the "Catechism in a Year" Podcast. Fr Schmitz's "Bible in a Year" was the most popular Podcast in America, so I have high hopes for this new endeavor. As part of the new Catechism in a Year podcast, I would like to meet with those interested in developing a deeper understanding of the Church's doctrine. I am proposing that anyone interested meet together every week, on Mondays, to go further into the Catechisms from the previous week, hopefully to help answer any questions that may have arisen from the podcast. Since the Podcast will begin on Thursday, January 1st, I'm proposing that we begin the classes on Monday January 16th (from 7:00-8:30 in the Hall) in order to provide some extra time to get into the swing of things after the holidays. Each podcast is to be about 15 minutes in length, so it should not be too much of a daily burden.
