Building for the Future

By the 1990's, Shepherd of the Valley was struggling to make an

enlarged fruit-stand Church serve its many needs. For parish dinners, tables were brought into the church, and the sanctuary was closed off with a curtain. At other times, curtains divided class areas but provided virtually no sound separation. Other sites were used: Seder meals took place at Scenic Middle School, high school religion classes (often numbering as high as 25 students) met the living room of an East Medford home. In 1991, inspired by Fr. Vincent McGarvey and built under Fr. Jim Clifford, work began on what we know today as the Parish Hall was undertaken, funded by an outpouring from parishioners of nearly \$2.5 million dollars in today's currency.

The building made all the difference in the world. With its combination of flexible gathering space, fully equipped kitchen, bathrooms, office space and work rooms, it led to a remarkable growth in parish ministries and remains today a testament to the generosity and foresight of those who built it.

Construyendo para el Futuro

con puesto de frutas pudiera satisfacer sus múltiples necesidades. Para las cenas parroquiales, se llevaban mesas al interior de la iglesia y el santuario se cerraba con una cortina. En otras ocasiones, las cortinas dividían las áreas de clase, pero prácticamente no proporcionaban aislamiento acústico. Se utilizaron otros lugares: las comidas del Séder se celebraban en la Escuela Intermedia Scenic, las clases de religión de la escuela secundaria (que a menudo contaban con hasta 25 estudiantes) se reunían en la sala de estar de una casa en East Medford. En 1991, inspirado por el Padre Vincent McGarvey y construido bajo la dirección del Padre Jim Clifford, comenzaron las obras de lo que hoy conocemos como el Salón Parroquial, financiado con una generosa donación de los feligreses de casi 2.5 millones de dólares actuales. El edificio marcó una gran diferencia. Con su combinación de espacio de reunión flexible, cocina totalmente equipada, baños, espacio de oficina y salas de trabajo, provocó un crecimiento notable en los ministerios parroquiales y sigue siendo hoy un testimonio de la generosidad y la previsión de quienes lo construyeron.

ARCHBISHOP ALEXANDER K. SAMPLE'S STATEMENT ON THE ELECTION OF POPE LEO XIV

PORTLAND, MAY 8, 2025 // ARCHBISHOP ALEXANDER K. SAMPLE

It is with great joy that we receive the news that a new Pope has been elected to shepherd us in the universal Church. And the first Holy Father from the United States! We lift him up in prayer as he takes on this tremendous responsibility. May God grant him the grace to shepherd us according to the mind and heart of Christ. I entrust his ministry to the maternal care of Our Lady, Mary Mother of the Church.

Pope Leo XIV elected as Supreme Pontiff

"Peace be with all of you!" - With these

words, Pope Leo XIV greeted the world for the first time. The Conclave has elected Robert Francis Cardinal Prevost as the 267th Bishop of Rome. His election was announced from the central loggia of St. Peter's Basilica by Cardinal Protodeacon Dominique Mamberti.

The First Augustinian, First American Pope

Born September 14, 1955, in Chicago, Illinois, Robert Francis Prevost is the first Pope from the Order of Saint Augustine and the second Pontiff from the Americas, after Pope Francis. Though from the United States, he spent over a decade as a missionary in Peru.


Early Life and Formation

He is the son of Louis Marius Prevost, of French-Italian descent, and Mildred Martínez, of Spanish heritage. He joined the Augustinian Minor Seminary, earned a degree in Mathematics and Philosophy from Villanova University (1977), and entered the Augustinian novitiate that same year. He made solemn profession on August 29, 1981.

He studied theology at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago, then was sent to Rome for Canon Law studies at the Pontifical University of Saint Thomas Aquinas (Angelicum). He was ordained a priest on June 19, 1982, in Rome.

Missionary and Educator in Peru

Prevost earned his doctorate in Canon Law in 1987 and began missionary work in Chulucanas and Trujillo, Peru. Over eleven years, he served as prior, formation director, judicial vicar, and professor in Trujillo's major seminary. He also led parishes in underserved areas, including Saint Rita and Our Lady of Monserrat.



Leadership in the Augustinian Order

In 1999, he was elected Provincial Prior of the Chicago-based Province of "Mother of Good Counsel." In 2001, he was elected Prior General of the Order of Saint Augustine, and re-elected in 2007.

Episcopal Ministry in Peru

Appointed Apostolic Administrator of Chiclayo in 2014, he was ordained bishop on December 12, Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. He became Bishop of Chiclayo in 2015 and held several national Church leadership roles, including Vice-President of the Peruvian Episcopal Conference.

He served on Vatican congregations, including the Dicastery for Bishops, and in 2020 was named Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Callao.

Prefect and Cardinal

On January 30, 2023, Pope Francis named him Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops and President of the Pontifical Commission for Latin America, raising him to the rank of Archbishop. He was created a Cardinal on September 30, 2024, and assigned the Diaconate of Saint Monica.

He participated in papal journeys and both sessions of the Synod on Synodality. On February 6, 2025, he was promoted to the Order of Bishops, receiving the title of the Suburbicarian See of Albano.

In March 2025, during Pope Francis's hospitalization, Cardinal Prevost led the faithful in praying the Rosary for the Holy Father's health in St. Peter's Square.

His episcopal motto, "In Illo uno unum" ("In the one Christ, we are one"), reflects his Augustinian vision of unity in the Body of Christ.


