## PILGRIMAGE - THE HOLY DOOR

From a symbolic viewpoint, the Holy Door takes on a special significance: it is the most powerful sign of the Jubilee, since the ultimate aim of the pilgrim is to pass through it. The opening of the door by the Pope constitutes the official beginning of the Holy Year. Originally, there was only one door, at the Basilica of St. John Lateran, which is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome. Later, to allow as many pilgrims as possible to take part in the Jubilee experience, the other Roman Basilicas also opened their own holy doors.

In crossing the threshold of the Holy Door, the pilgrim is reminded of the passage from chapter 10 of St John's gospel: "I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture." Passing through the Holy Door expresses the decision to follow and be guided by Jesus, who is the Good Shepherd. The door is a passageway that ushers the pilgrim into the interior of a church. For the Christian community, a church is not only a sacred space, to be approached with respect, with appropriate behavior and dress code, but it is a symbol of the communion that binds every believer to Christ: it is a place of encounter and dialogue, of reconciliation and peace which awaits every pilgrim, the Church is essentially the place of the community of the faithful.

In Rome, this experience takes on a special significance because of the special links between the Eternal City and Saints Peter and Paul, the apostles who founded the Christian community in Rome and whose teachings and example are models for the universal Church. The tombs of Saints Peter and Paul are located in Rome, they were martyred here; and together with the catacombs, these sacred sites are places of continuous spiritual inspiration.

## MARRIAGES

If you plan to get married in Church next year, we ask you to call the Church office to make an appointment with Fr. Silverino. The first documents to bring on your first appointment include but are not limited to the following: Baptism Certificate, First Holy Communion Certificate, Confirmation Certificate. If you were married before and you are divorced, bring your divorce decree. If you have been married by Justice of the Peace, bring your state marriage license and the marriage certificate.

For every marriage, we always require the following additional information: Look for our witnesses, those who know you very well such as family members or friends. Also, we will need two official witnesses who are the official witnesses of your wedding in Church. Help us to put all this information together to make the marriage process easy.

Remember that you need to make the first appointment at least 6 months prior to your wedding date.

### THE ROAD

History can have a long tail. When conversations with the Central Point planning department earlier this year on the Faith and Learning Center, it emerged that approval would be contingent on implementing a deferred development agreement between

the city and parish in the summer of 2012. In obtaining the building permit for the new church, the parish agreed to a share in the improvement costs of costs of improving the approximately 450 feet of access road along the west side of the parish property. This two-lane thoroughfare that included sidewalks, planting strips, and underground utilities.

With the Willow Bend Estates build-out now imminent, the parish saves considerable expenses by collaborating on this project. Although the improved roadway is not directly part of the Faith and Learning Center campaign (the project is budgeted separately), it benefits from providing a full-width street between the parish property and planned residences, as well as improved access to sewer and fire-hydrant connections.





### LA CARRETERA

La historia puede tener una larga cola. A principios de este año, durante las conversaciones con el departamento de planificación de Central Point sobre el Centro de Fe y Aprendizaje, se supo que la aprobación estaría sujeta a la implementación de

un acuerdo de desarrollo diferido entre la ciudad y la parroquia en el verano de 2012. Al obtener el permiso de construcción para la nueva iglesia, la parroquia aceptó compartir los costos de mejora de los aproximadamente 137 metros de camino de acceso a lo largo del lado oeste de la propiedad parroquial. Esta vía de dos carriles incluía aceras, franjas de plantación y servicios públicos subterráneos.

Con la inminente construcción de Willow Bend Estates, la parroquia ahorra gastos considerables al colaborar en este proyecto. Si bien la mejora de la carretera no forma parte directamente de la campaña del Centro de Fe y Aprendizaje (el proyecto se presupuesta aparte), se beneficia al proporcionar una calle de ancho completo entre la propiedad parroquial y las viviendas planificadas, así como un mejor acceso a las conexiones de alcantarillado e hidrantes.



The access road will soon be replaced by a full-width street serving several block area of new Central Point housing.
