
Saint Maximilian Kolbe Church August 6, 2017



St. John Mary Vianney (Feast Day August 4)

Despite a less than stellar scholastic career, which included difficulties learning Latin, St. John Vianney was eventually ordained a priest. What he seemingly lacked in academics he more than made up for with his gift of being a great confessor.



In winter months, he was known to spend 11-12 hours reconciling souls to God; in summer months, it could be a long as 15-16 hours. Even though he would be weary at the end of the day, the devil often tormented him so that he couldn't get more than a few hours of sleep. Because of his dedication to his parishioners, he is the patron saint of all priests, but most especially parish priests.



PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM 2017-2018 REGISTRATION

Registration is open for K-6th grade PREP classes next fall; forms are available from the PREP office or on the website at www.stmax.org/PREP. 1st grade is required preparation for the 2nd grade sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist.

<u>Volunteers Needed</u>: God wants all children to know of his love and care for them! If you would be willing to help our parish fulfill this mission we have the following opportunities in our Tuesday night PREP program:

Catechists – We are in need of a lead teacher for grade 4 in the late session (6:30-7:45). Must be over 18.

Office Assistance – Help with clerical projects and receptionist responsibilities. We are especially in need of a front desk assistant during the late (6:30-7:45 pm) session.

Car-Line Safety – Short shift and very important! Help students safely get out of cars, cross traffic and enter the building. Early session assistance needed from 4:30-4:50; late session assistance from 6:15-6:35. Adults or high school students are able to fill this role.

Classroom Aides – Assist with instruction and/or class management. Adults or high school students are able to fill this role.

Special Events – If you are not able to commit to every Tuesday but would still like to support the PREP program, we do need help with special projects or events that occur occasionally throughout the year.

All adult volunteers must complete the safety clearances required by federal/state law and Archdiocese policy. This is great opportunity for high school students seeking Community Service Hours required by Catholic schools and National Honor Society.


