Turn your ear, O Lord, and answer me; save the servant who trusts in you, my God. Have mercy on me, O Lord, for I cry to you all the day long.

READING I: JOS 24:1-2A, 15-17, 18B

Every time the covenant is renewed, the people have a choice: "If it does not please you to serve the Lord, decide today whom you will serve."

For us, the Eucharist is a time of covenant renewal that charges us to make the same choice.

READING II: EPH 5:21-32

Not only should we try to "understand what is the will of the Lord," we should put it into practice in all of our life—a goal expressed in our common "psalms and hymns and spiritual songs."

GOSPEL: JN 6:60-69

Jesus' audience seems to take what he says about his flesh quite literally. Jesus responds by seeming to repeat and emphasize what he said, but its expansion in terms of life suggests that this may be a good occasion to address the sacramental understanding of the Eucharist.

COMMUNION ANTIPHON: JN 6:54

Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, says the Lord, and I will raise him up on the last day.

**INDOOR FACE COVERINGS REINSTATED IN MONT. COUNTY**

Effective Saturday, August 7th at 12:01 a.m., Montgomery County has reinstated the use of masks/face coverings for all persons in the County over the age of two years old when in any public indoor location or gathering. This is because according to CDC data, and as reported by local public health officials, Montgomery County is currently in the "Substantial Transmission" status which means that the County is experiencing an average of 50-99.9 new cases of the Covid-19 Delta variant per 100k persons within the last 7 days. The mask mandate will end when the County returns to a "moderate transmission" status for 7 consecutive days.
