for the poor and lowly.

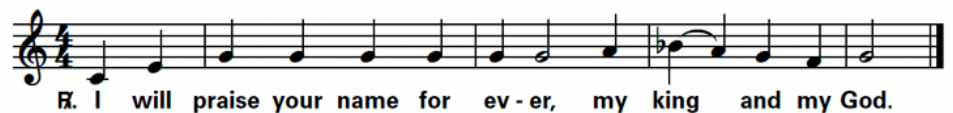
Reading II: Rom 8:9, 11-13

"in the spirit" believe in the promise held

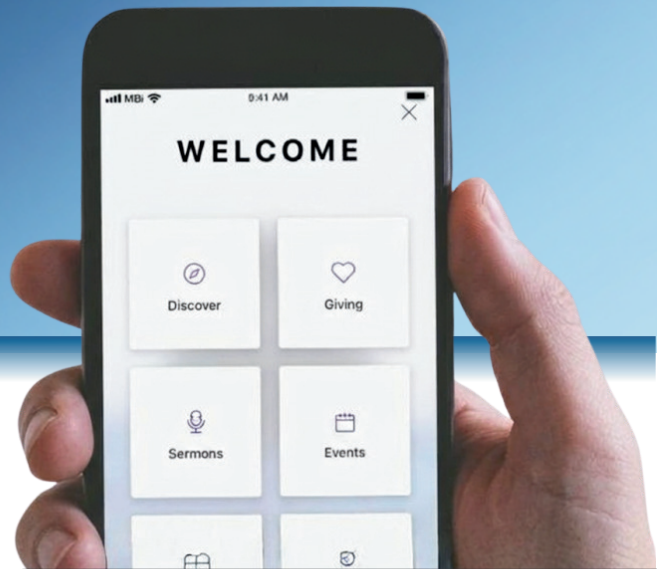
IN OUR PARISH

EMAIL SCAM WARNING AND RECOVERY RESOURCES

Please be aware that phishing email scams are continuously being sent to members of our community. These email tactics use names of religious leaders as a ploy to scam you into sending money or buy gift cards, and becomes more prominent during the Easter and Christmas seasons. Fr. Giese's name is being used in some of them; these emails are not coming from Fr. Giese or staff of St. Jane. Our parish receives online donations only through our e-giving provider, ParishSoft Giving. Some versions of these phishing emails may also contain attachments and QR codes that may pertain to the "Policies" of St. Jane de Chantal Church. All emails from St. Jane de Chantal, or from the Archdiocese of Washington have distinguishable details that identify us and the purpose of the email. If the sender did not put enough recognizable details in an email for you to be comfortable with its origin and purpose, please do not respond, and please do not open their attachments or scan any embedded QR codes. If you are a victim of a phishing email scam, incidents can be reported - to the "Internet Crime Complaint Center" at ic3.gov. You can also report this to the Maryland Department of Human Services at 1-800-91-PREVENT. 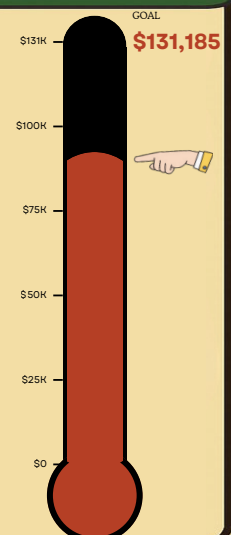
