

Readings in Worship hymnal # 1124

Be my protector, O God, a mighty stronghold to save me. For you are my rock, my stronghold! Lead me, guide me, for the sake of your name.

Reading I: Sir 15:15-20

Traditional moral teaching divided human behavior into two "ways:" the way of life and the way of death. God calls people to follow the way of life and does not force anyone into the way of death.

Psalm Response: Ps 119

These excerpts from the longest psalm in the Psalter (176 verses!) praise both those who follow God's way and the law (Torah) which lays out that way. The final verse of today's excerpt asks for wisdom—insight into how everything fits together in God's plan.

Reading II: 1 Cor 2:6-10

Paul indicates that he taught at several levels. There is the basic announcement of the Good News (see last week's second reading), but he also taught in deeper ways (and, probably, relying more on his rabbinical training) for those who could understand it. Still, he claims no credit for this deeper teaching: It is the work of the Spirit.
