Entrance Antiphon:

Jer 29: 11, 12, 14

The Lord said: I think thoughts of peace and not of affliction. You will call upon me, and I will answer you, and I will lead back your captives from every place.

Reading I: Mal 3:19-20a

The prophet sees the day of the Lord as dawning with fire to burn the unjust and with light to enliven the just.

Psalm Response: Ps 98

In this enthronement hymn, all of creation joins in glorious song and music to acclaim the Lord.

Reading II: 2 Thes 3:7-12

Paul encourages this community to continue to live just and upright lives, not just sit back and wait for the dawning of the Lord's new day.

Gospel: Lk 21:5-19

People at the time of Jesus believed that history would end in violent disruption. This reading reflects that belief, but it also calls on Jesus' followers to trust in God, no matter what might happen.
