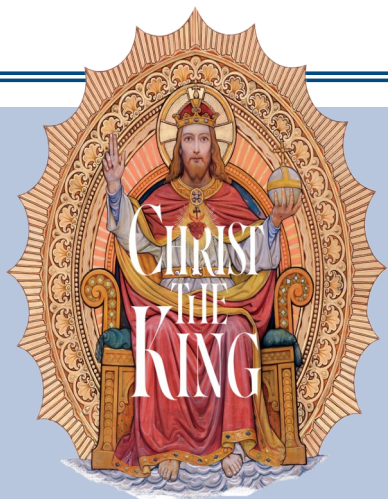


# THE ORDER OF WORSHIP

**Entrance Antiphon: Rev 5:12; 1:6**

How worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and divinity, and wisdom and strength and honor. To him belong glory and power for ever and ever.

**Reading I: 2 Sm 5:1-3**

The tribes of Israel pledge allegiance to David because they believe he is God’s anointed ruler.

**Psalm Response: Ps 122**

This “song of ascent,” sung by pilgrims headed to Jerusalem, reflects the city’s role as the center of Davidic rule and of worship. Christians often use this psalm as an image of the New Jerusalem.

**Reading II: Col 1:12-20**

Paul borrows an early hymn text to describe the One to whom we owe allegiance: the firstborn of all creation; the head of the body, the Church; and the firstborn from the dead.
