What is the Pastoral Council?

A volunteer group of elected
parishioners who serve where needed to
promote communication, arrange parish
events, coordinate with parish
committees, and advise the Pastor on a
wide range of issues.

Who May Serve on the PC?

- Any registered parishioner in good standing who is at least 18-years old and representative of the faithful of the Parish.
 - No specific training or experience is required.

What do PC Members Do and What is the Expected Level of Effort?

- Candidates are nominated, elected, and then appointed for a Three-Year Term.
- New Members serve as a liaison to specific Parish Committees and lead or assist in planning and executing parish-wide events and special projects as they arise.
- Meetings occur monthly on Thursday evenings from September through May.
- Approximately five hours of effort/obligation per month, in coordination, planning, service, and occasional public announcements, unless specific projects require more.
