found nowhere else in the Bible.

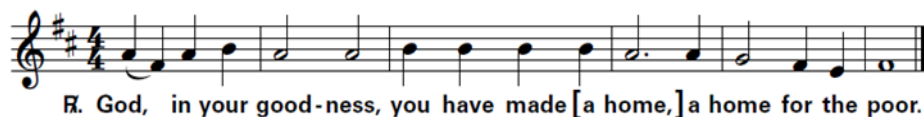
Reading II: Heb 12:18-19, 22-24a

presence to teach believers about
the proper approach to God in
prayer. They are not approaching the
God of thunder and lightning on
Mount Sinai; they are approaching
the God of the Jerusalem Temple, but
they are approaching this God as
Father, for they are coming through
"Jesus, the mediator of a new
covenant."

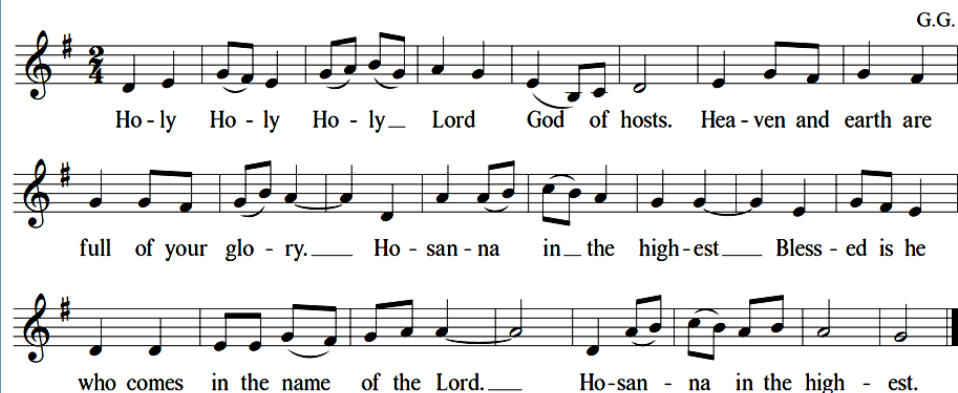

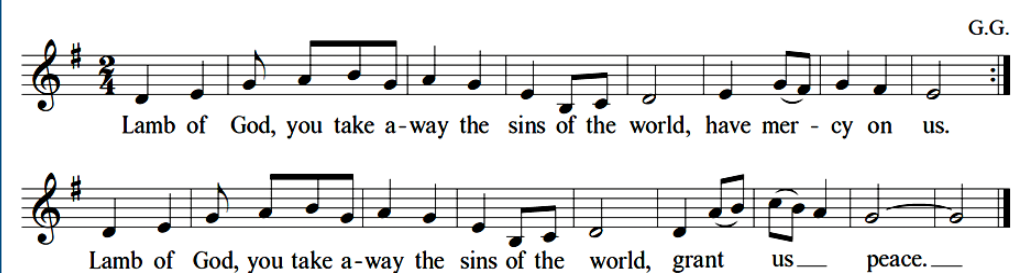
