Entrance Antiphon: Ps 43:1-2

Give me justice, O God, and plead my cause against a nation that is faithless. From the deceitful and cunning rescue me, for you, O God, are my strength.

Reading I: Ez 37:12-14

God promises to restore the people to their homeland and to give them a rebirth of faith.

Psalm Response: Ps 130

“With the Lord there is mercy, and fullness of redemption.” Psalm 130 is another traditional “penitential psalm.” Like Psalm 51, it is used by the Church during seasons and rituals of repentance. It sings of another kind of “resurrection”— the restoration of someone who is suffering, who has experienced God’s mercy, forgiveness, and redemption.

Reading II: Rom 8:8-11

Paul uses “flesh” to mean those who have not come to belief in Christ and “spirit” to mean those who have. For those who believe, the Spirit is at work restoring all of creation and raising it to the new life given us in Christ.

Gospel: Jn 11:1-45

The story of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus makes some points similar to those made in the previous week’s Gospel: You need to see things from God’s perspective in order to understand

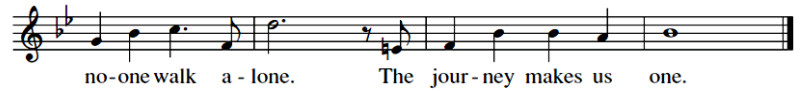
