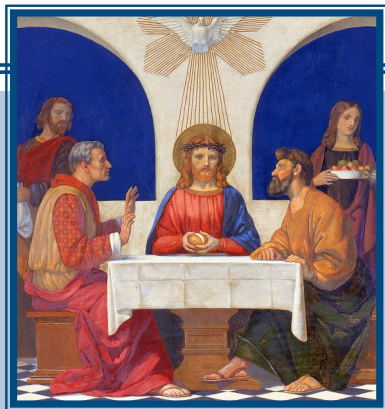


# THE ORDER OF WORSHIP

**Entrance Antiphon: Ps 66:1-2**

Cry out with joy to God, all the earth;  
O sing to the glory of his name.  
O render him glorious praise, alleluia.

**Reading I: Acts 2:14, 22-33**

This is the first of six discourses in Acts (along with Acts 3:12–26; 4:8–12; 5:29–32; 10:34–43; 13:16–41) dealing with the resurrection of Jesus and its messianic import. Five of these are attributed to Peter, the final one to Paul. Modern scholars term these discourses in Acts the “kerygma,” the Greek word for proclamation.

**Psalm Response: Ps 16**

“Lord, you will show us the path of life.” This prayer for protection includes at its heart an extended reflection of what it means to believe in the One God.

**Reading II: 1 Pt 1:17-21**

Christians have received the redemption prophesied by Isaiah (Is 52:3), through the blood (Jewish symbol of life) of the spotless lamb (1 Pt 19).

**Gospel: Lk 24:13-35**

The resurrection narrative in Luke consists of five sections:
