Moses reminds the Israelites of all
that had happened to them during the
years of desert wandering.
This is so that when they enter the land,
enjoyment of its fruits and comforts will
not cause them to become forgetful of
their dependence upon the Lord.

Psalm Response: Ps 147

The psalm praises God continues to
care for Israel within the land as God
cared for Israel on its journey to the
land. the psalm claims that God has
provided security and peace for the land
and its people as God provided
protection for the "children" from the
perils of the wilderness.

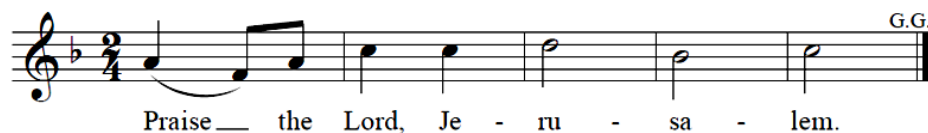
Reading II: 1 Cor 10:16-17

The significance of the cup of wine
is not in its material substance
but in its incorporation of the partakers
in the blood of Christ.
It is through Christ's death-blood that
we participate in his life-blood.
Community is established with the
breaking of the bread, not with
the subsequent eating of it.
Paul insists that when we partake in
the Eucharist, it does not so much
become part of us as does other food,
but we are transformed into it.

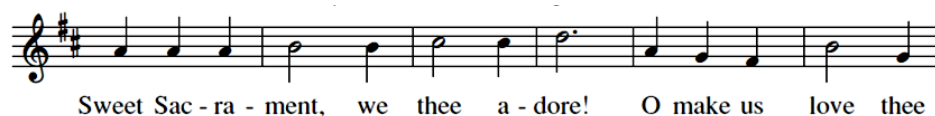
*1 Jesus, my Lord, my God, my All,
