Solomon prays for wisdom,
which means the ability
“to distinguish right from wrong.”
God gives him such an ability,
which seems to be in short supply,
since there is “no one to equal”

(longest in the Book of Psalms)
in praise of the Torah, which
Israel considered God’s greatest
covenant gift— a guide to

Gospel: Mt 13:44-52

The first two parables actually tell
the stories of two people who cheat
to gain great fortunes: the first by
disguising what is found in a field
and the second by using “insider

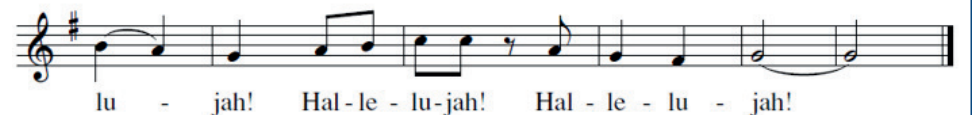
