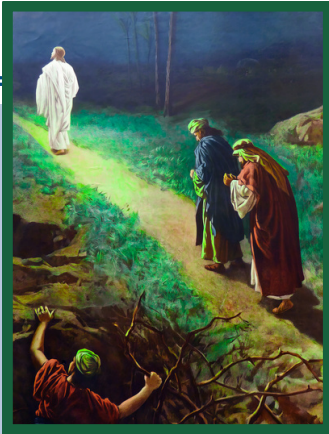

### Entrance Antiphon: Ps 86: 3, 5

Have mercy on me, O Lord,  
for I cry to you all the day long.  
O Lord, you are good and forgiving,  
full of mercy to all who call to you.

### Reading I: Jer 20:7-9

Jeremiah preached while the world  
as he knew it was crumbling.  
The Babylonians were attacking  
Jerusalem. Yet the religious leaders  
and others refused to heed his  
words. Indeed, they did all they  
could to discredit him.  
It is no wonder Jeremiah in this  
passage cries out in frustration.  
But his faith is greater than his fear.

### Psalm Response: Ps 63:2, 3-4, 5-6, 8-9

"My soul is thirsting for you, O Lord  
my God." Following the passage  
from Jeremiah, the psalm resonates  
with the deep pleading and  
assurance of one whose trust is  
completely in God.

### Reading II: Rom 12:1-2

This short passage begins a new  
section in Romans. Paul asks the  
people to be open to the  
transformation that God gives.  
We too are called to let go of  
conventions of the way  
things were and let God teach us  
how things should be.

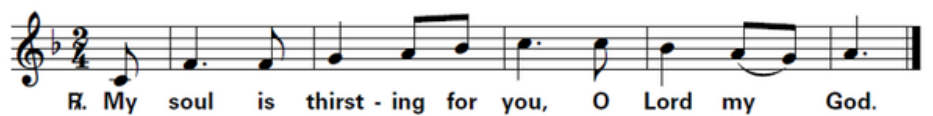
### Gospel: Mt 16:21-27
