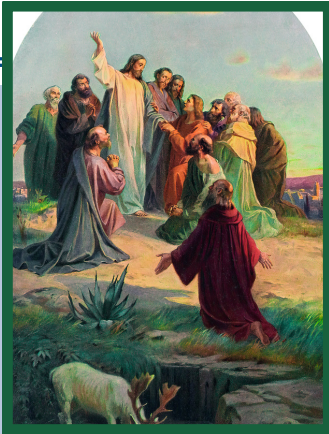

Entrance Antiphon: Ps 119:137, 124

You are just, O Lord, and your judgment is right; treat your servant in accord with your merciful love.

Reading I: Ez 33:7-9

The prophet is informed that God has appointed him as a sentinel to “the house of Israel.” Ezekiel is to communicate God’s warning to each person so that he or she can repent of wickedness and live. It is rather strange to our thinking that if the prophet fails to warn a wicked person he or she still dies for their sins.

Psalm Response: Ps 95

This responsorial psalm is used to commence the first “hour” or portion of the “Prayer of the Church” or the “Divine Office”, whether one commences with the Office of Readings or Morning Prayer.

As such, Christian practice is in keeping with its usage by Israel in biblical times; the psalm gives every indication of having been composed as part of Israel’s temple liturgy

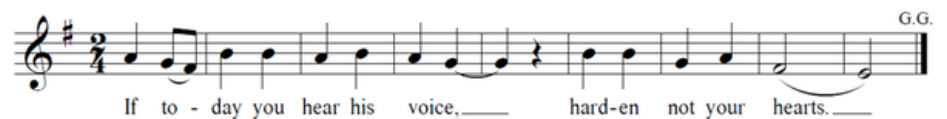
Reading II: Rom 13:8-10
