The Sixth Week of Ordinary Time is a brief week as it concludes on Tuesday night. You may know that we will have a Holy Hour on Tuesday evening, February 13 at 7pm, following our Taco dinner as part of the parish's Feasting to Fasting event. Then we begin our **Lenten journey** on Ash Wednesday, February 14.


Throughout Masses during the first three weeks of our Lenten journey, Holy Mother Church takes readings from the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark and Luke) and from the Old Testament. The common theme we will hear is a **call to a life of Gospel conversion**.

St. John Paul II teaches us that Our Lady perfectly shows each of us how to take up the call to a life of Gospel conversion in four ways:

- First, in her generous desire to do all that God wanted of her.
- Second, in her total acceptance of God's will.
- Third, in the <u>consistency</u> between her life and the commitment of faith which she made each day of her life.
- Finally, fourth, in her withstanding all trials... Mary's fiat in the Annunciation finds its fullness in the silent 'fiat' that she *repeats* at the foot of the Cross.

As we begin our Lenten journey, let us ask for the grace to **repent and believe in the Gospel** and let us prayerfully petition for Our Lady's heavenly intercession for a holy Lent.
