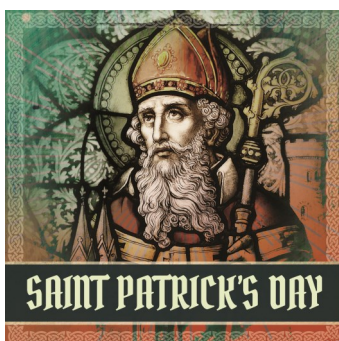
Follow a series of meditations and prayers that follow Mary's thoughts and words from Jesus's Passion to His death.
