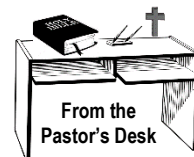

Dear Parishioners,

As we continue to move forward and see parishioners rejoining us in greater numbers, you will also notice some changes happening in and around the Church. Railings will be installed near the pulpit (ambo). This is being done both for accessibility and out of concern for safety. Folks will now have a handrail as they ascend and descend the steps. It will also be impossible to turn to the right and step off of the sanctuary. This has happened numerous times, especially during funerals and weddings with people who are unfamiliar with the sanctuary. I am so pleased that we can finally move forward with this addition which will assist people and make them safe.

Our next project will be to expand the sanctuary on the right side to mirror the bump out of the sanctuary on the left side where the pulpit stands. This will allow us to place the Presider's chair and the Deacon's chair out of the central focus to allow room for us to move the tabernacle to the central axis of the church. Because COVID-19 has affected contractors tremendously, I cannot give specific dates on completion of these projects, but I wanted you to know that these improvements **are** coming. We will update you further on outside accessibility improvements in future communications.

Estimados feligreses,

A medida que continuamos avanzando y vemos que los feligreses se unen a nosotros en mayor número, también notará algunos cambios que están sucediendo dentro y alrededor de la Iglesia. Se instalarán barandillas cerca del púlpito (ambón). Esto se hace tanto por la accesibilidad como por la seguridad. Las personas ahora tendrán un pasamanos mientras suben y bajan los escalones. También será imposible girar a la derecha y salir del santuario. Esto ha sucedido en numerosas ocasiones, especialmente durante los funerales y bodas con personas que no están familiarizadas con el santuario. Estoy muy contento de que finalmente podamos avanzar con esta adición que ayudará a las personas y las hará seguras.

Nuestro próximo proyecto será expandir el santuario en el lado derecho para reflejar la protuberancia del santuario en el lado izquierdo donde se encuentra el púlpito. Esto nos permitirá colocar la silla del Celebrante y la silla del Diácono fuera del foco central para dejar espacio para que podamos mover el tabernáculo al eje central de la iglesia. Debido a que COVID-19 ha afectado enormemente a los contratistas, no puedo dar fechas específicas sobre la finalización de estos proyectos, pero quería que supieran que estas mejoras están por llegar. Ella lo vio, y lloró amarga y desconsoladamente, roto y clavado en la cruz. ¿Hay algo que duela más que un hijo? La resurrección de Jesús supuso para María revivir gozosamente la inolvidable frase del ángel Gabriel: “Para Dios no hay nada imposible”.

Decía San Agustín que vivir el tiempo de Pascua consistiría sencillamente en imitar con prontitud las virtudes de María. Imitar a María no es caer en la adoración hacia ella únicamente. Jesús nunca nos daría, como modelo a imitar, ha alguien que nos apartara de él, así que si nos dio a la Santísima Virgen fue porque ciertamente en ella encontramos a una persona humana que se dio a la causa del amor, que resistió el dolor de ver morir a su propio Hijo en la Cruz, que ante todo, respondió a la voluntad del Padre porque no cualquiera se lanza a la misión que María tuvo, no cualquiera resiste los dolores que ella experimentó, en fin, en ella tenemos a una amiga, a una compañera y sobre todo a una madre en quien confiar.

Vivamos juntamente con María, la pascua del Señor, y celebrar un día con ella la verdadera pascua, que es el cielo.

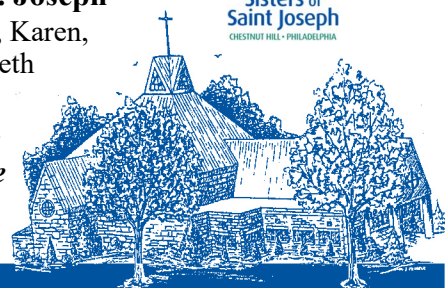

Parish Ministry Spotlight

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

We are a Montessori-based catechesis for children from ages 3-12. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd was born from the joy of the children in their encounter with God. It is an experience of *life*, an education in *faith*, and a celebration of the encounter with the Father — in listening to Jesus, the one Teacher, and in obedience to the Holy Spirit.

Children who come to the Good Shepherd find a prepared environment called the “Atrium” that responds to their vital religious needs and helps them listen and meditate upon our faith presentations that follow the Church year. The Atrium is not a place to entertain children. Here they are given the richness of faith!

We don’t teach answers. We give children the facts about Jesus and let them discover on their own. For example, Jesus said, “*I am the Good Shepherd*.” He never said who the sheep are, and neither do we. The children come to that revelation on their own!

Join in the wonder of 3-6-year-olds: these children are particularly capable of receiving and enjoying the most essential elements of our faith — the announcement of God’s love experienced through Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who died and is risen.

Celebrate the growth of 6-9-year-olds: they are captured by the image of the True Vine, which responds to the deep need of these children to better know their relationships with God, family, friends, and the larger community.

THE THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER



Parents play the primary role in educating their children about sexual abuse. Here are 5 tips for teaching safety to the little ones God has entrusted to you:

1: Keep it practical.

Teach your children the differences between safe touches and unsafe touches.

2: Tell your children that saying “no” is okay.

Empower your children to say “no” if anyone makes them feel uncomfortable or touches them inappropriately.

3: Give your children a way to alert you.

Tell your children they can use an excuse or share a special “code-word” with you to alert you about an unsafe person or situation.

4: Tell your children to report an unsafe touch.

Let your children know they should tell you if they feel uncomfortable or unsafe around any adult or peer. You can also identify other adults they can tell about unsafe touches.

5: Tell your children you trust them.

If your child makes a report to you, believe him or her. Tell them it is not their fault and that you love them. Immediately bring the allegation to the attention of public authorities.

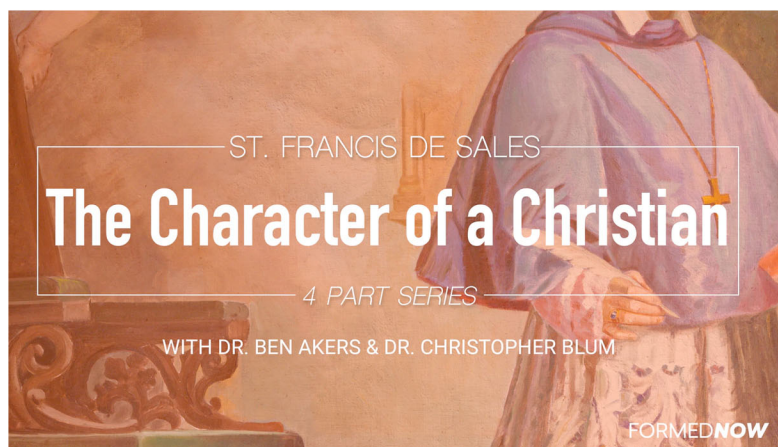

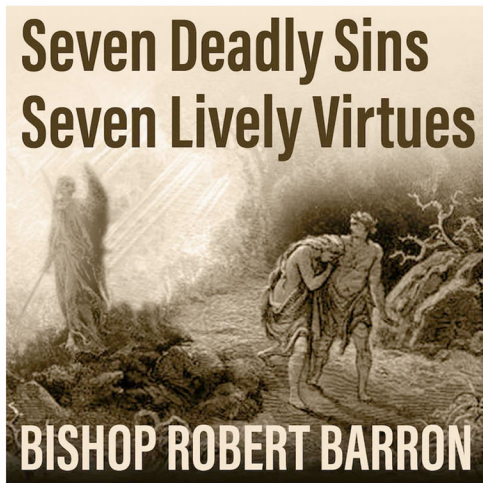

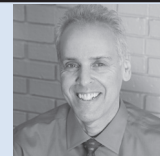
