FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I don't know if you've been counting. I know we should not brag, but it gives me great hope to know that we received 42 people into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. We were able to share Jesus in the Eucharist with 152 children for their First Eucharist last week and 5 more individual children with their families at the 9:30 am Mass. Another adult who, for health reasons, could not come to the Easter Vigil came into the Church, was confirmed and received her First Eucharist at that same Mass. This weekend, we will witness the Holy Spirit come upon 143 of our young people and we are still anticipating two (2) more people to enter the Church this Easter Season and many more First Communions as well. Our parish is alive and thriving!

Numbers are not enough, however. All of these people who have received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and/or Eucharist) need to remain or become intimately involved with their faith on a weekly, if not daily, basis. And we, who are inspired that they have taken time to study and reflect, should also deepen our devotion and commitment to the Catholic Church and an appreciation of the Sacraments we have all received.

If you have not been confirmed and would like to receive the Sacrament, we can offer opportunities to prepare for Confirmation as an adult. 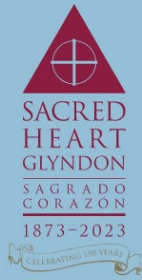
