FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

Most people in the early church, first through the third century, feared dying for being a Christian. They knew that making a decision for Christ, coming to the Eucharist and living His commands, made them enemies of the state. Many of them personally witnessed friends, family members and neighbors tortured and killed simply because they were Christian and would not give up their faith. However, even earlier in time people suffered for their faith. Jeremiah speaks of this in the first reading where he talks about "terror on every side." People are denouncing him, he is thrown into a cistern to drown (fortunately there is not water!) and persecuted day after day.

We may think those days are over and they certainly are for those who have given up their faith, don't come to any church any more or don't profess the faith. But for we who try to live the Gospel, keep the commandments and admonitions of Jesus and speak up for real Truth, persecution has and will come to us. Our country, unfortunately, is coming to see Christianity as a threat. When we speak up for the immigrant we are told we are unpatriotic-that "they" should come into the country legally. True, but have you ever worked with anyone who has tried to come into the country legally? When we stand up for the rights of the unborn, the human person in the womb, we are told we are insensitive to women and their rights. And when we stand up for basic moral principles, almost universally accepted 30 years ago, we are told we are exclusionary. Not only are we sidelined in the media, in conversation and in the political parties, people are now being attacked physically. (Note the man in front of the Pregnancy Center a couple of weeks ago.) My friends, if you stand up for what Jesus asks us to do, you will be persecuted. Be ready to join a long and illustrious list of men, women and even children who have witnessed to the faith for more than 2,000 years.


