

### FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Weather affects us tremendously. Look at the extreme heat this summer, especially in the Southwest and in Florida. Consider the tornadoes that hit the mid-West and the South. Even the storms this week in our area have people rearranging their plans, hunkering down and sometimes being frightened. Humans have always reacted to the weather and, oftentimes, out of fear. Poor Elijah today sits at the entrance to the cave and experiences a strong and heavy wind that is crushing rocks! Then, he undergoes an earthquake. Either of these are enough to make us tremble. Fire then burns before him on the mountain. At this point, Elijah must have had enough. But in all of these shows of force, while Elijah is trembling, God comes in a small whispering sound to calm Elijah and let him know he is safe.

Jesus does the same in the Gospel this weekend. He has gone off by Himself to pray after the multiplication of the loaves and the fish and the feeding of 5,000. As he is praying, the disciples are alone in the boat and a terrible storm comes up and threatens to overwhelm and drown them. In the tempest, Jesus appears! He walks on the water to let them know that He has power over the forces of nature and then He bids Peter to come to Him in the midst of the storm. Jesus does the same for each of us. Our lives sometimes can feel like we are being battered by the wind, threatened by the earth shaking, or standing up against fire. In the midst of the storm, look for Jesus. He is always there with His calming and loving presence. Notice in the Gospel that Jesus IMMEDIATELY reaches out His hand when Peter calls for help. He does the same for us.
