# FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

In the Broadway musical, Avenue Q, there is a moment when the puppets talk about Jesus' nationality. One claims He was black, another says He was white, while another says, "Jesus was Jewish," to which they all laugh! While Avenue Q promotes some morally questionable material for us as Christians, it does raise a very important popular bias for view. Many people, many Christians, do not believe that Jesus was Jewish nor that His mother, Mary, nor His father, Joseph, were also Jewish. If they do acknowledge Jesus as Jewish, they presume He was not a "real Jew." Unthinkingly, they see Jesus as Christian and His family as Christian. Jesus was Jewish and part of the belief system then was that God chose the Jewish people as His own, as the people of the Covenant and that you must join the Jewish faith to know the one true God.

The readings for this weekend would have then shocked the Old Testament audience as well as that of St. Paul and Matthew. In the Old Testament, God declares that foreigners can join themselves to the Lord and serve Him. Imagine, those others can be saved! Paul speaks about His frustration in getting his Jewish brothers and sisters (remember Paul was Jewish as well!) to believe in Jesus and talks about taking the message to the pagans, the Gentiles. He does so but almost sadly reminisces about how God chose his people, the Jewish people and, even though they are not responding to Paul, the call of God is irrevocable. One may almost hear the anguish in Paul's voice. Finally, Jesus, in the Gospel, reflects the Jewish attitude of His day by not acknowledging the Canaanite woman. It is only after they play a curious word game that Jesus realizes the woman has a deep faith and heals her daughter. This would have shocked Matthew's Jewish audience who still believed God came to them first. The Jewish people are still God's people and, as we pray for and acknowledge on Good Friday, theirs are the prophets, the Law and the Covenant. God's Church, founded by Jesus is open to all. Just when we draw the line, God erases it.

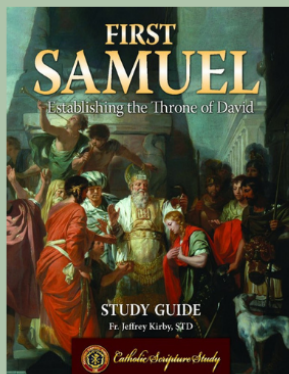
