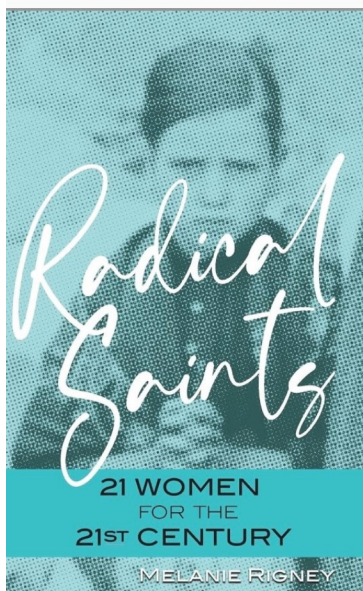

FROM THE PASTOR

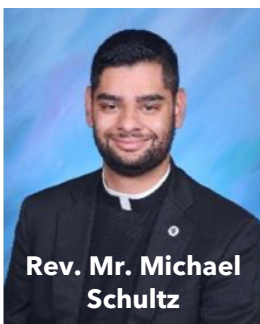
Dear Parishioners,

We are part of a community. We are not meant to be lone individuals. Relationships are a natural part of a healthy human life. This weekend's readings underscore the importance of community in a unique and often uncomfortable way. The first reading from the book of the prophet Ezekiel advises us that we are responsible for one another. We cannot look the other way when someone does wrong. God asks us to point out the sin so that the person can be saved. This takes clear, thinking, courage and diplomacy. In our culture, this kind of thinking is discouraged. We are advised to let everyone do what he or she thinks is best and look the other way. But God calls us to responsibility not only for ourselves but for our brothers and sisters.

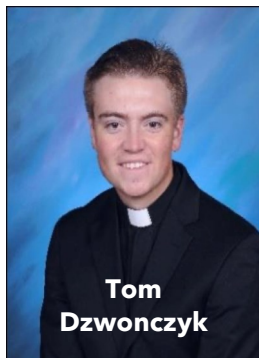
In the gospel reading as well, Jesus gives a whole process for "fraternal correction." It is a very wise approach to helping someone get on the right path. But notice, he never says, avoid pointing out the wrong.

None of us are perfect and so if we take on the correcting of someone else, we must always do so in humility, knowing that we ourselves have areas where we fall short.

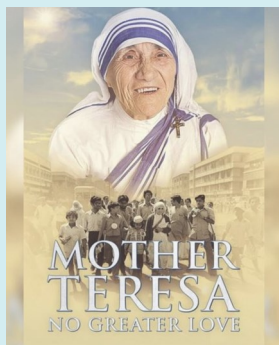
