



## FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

It is a natural kind of knee-jerk reaction to strike back when someone hits us. We have the same reaction when we are insulted or when someone does something wrong against us. We want to get even. We want revenge. But, as the first reading reminds us, wrath and anger are hateful things.

Striking back with violence only breeds more violence. We must show ourselves strong. Again, this is our natural instinct but, as thinking human beings, we must ask ourselves, what does it really accomplish in the long run? And as civilized beings, can't we find other ways to respond to others and build the human community, rather than lead it further into the path of darkness, evil, and violence?

We have just come through a week where we remembered the terrible events of 22 years ago, the attack on our country on September 11th. We entered into a 20 year war to try to solve the problem. And, although we did get the leader of the terrorist group, it seems that the country of Afghanistan is in worse shape now than it was then. Jesus' advice to pardon our brother seventy-seven times is Wisdom. How it applies practically to our life is for us to pray about and solve.


