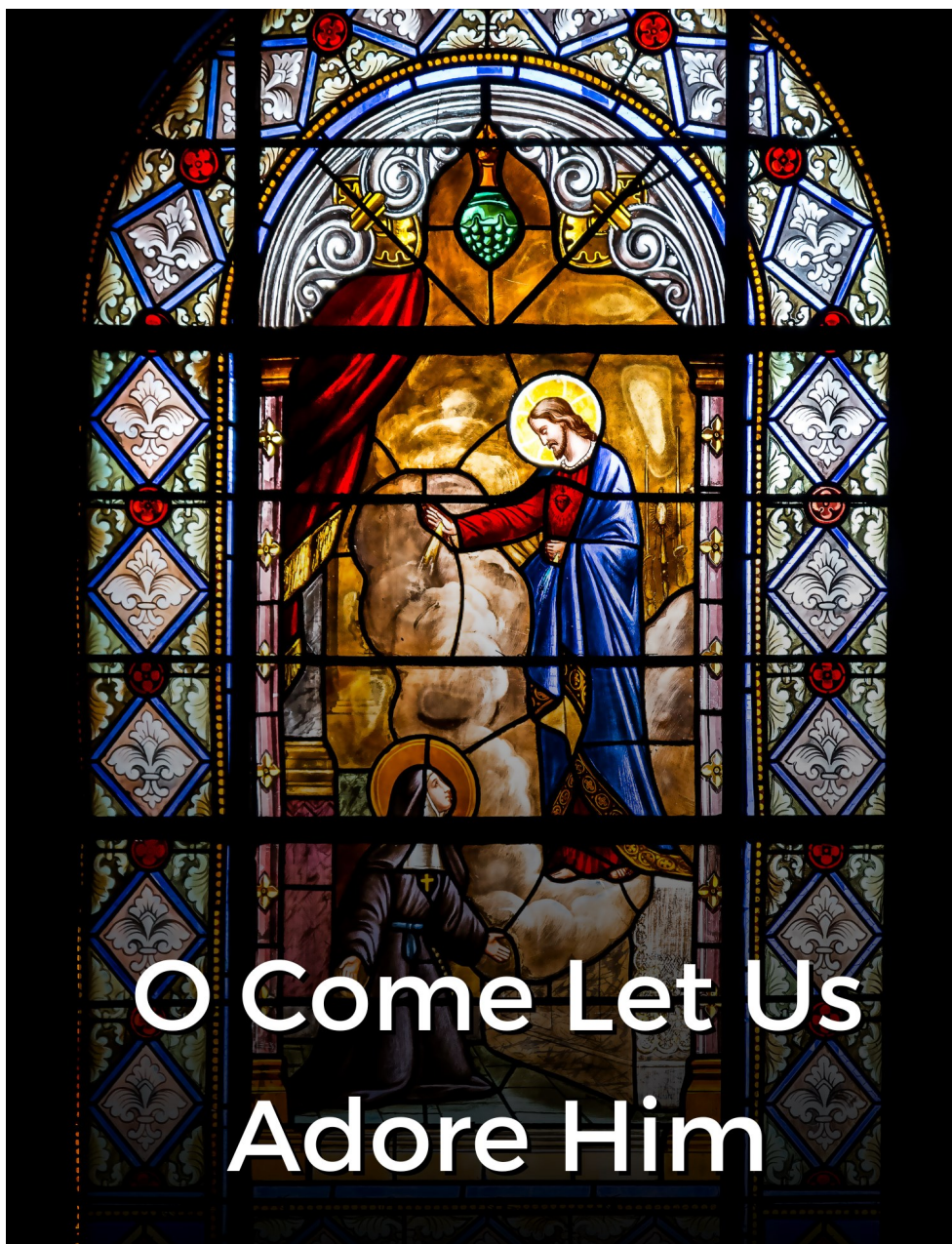

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

"O Come, O Come Emmanuel" is my favorite Advent hymn. I like the mysterious sound, the ancient feel, and the texts that use the O Antiphons of Advent because they express the deep longing our world has for the coming of Christ and His peace. As we embark on another Advent, our world seems worse than last year. War in the Ukraine is now topped by war in Israel and Gaza, while violence sweeps Sudan, other places in Africa and our own city of Baltimore. We desperately need peace—peace in our world, peace in our neighborhoods, peace in our own lives.

These first three weeks of Advent focus on the Second Coming of Christ at the end of time. We long for Jesus to return and restore the world to its original unity and love. The coming of the Savior promises the peace we hear in the prophet Isaiah. This is the first prayer of Advent as we light the first candle. The second part of Advent will then focus on the first coming of Jesus in Bethlehem in Judea.

Enter into each part of Advent. Allow yourself to forget about Christmas for just a bit and focus, instead, on Advent with its mystery, its glowing candles on the wreath and its wonderful chants and music that express our longing for Jesus and His unity and peace.

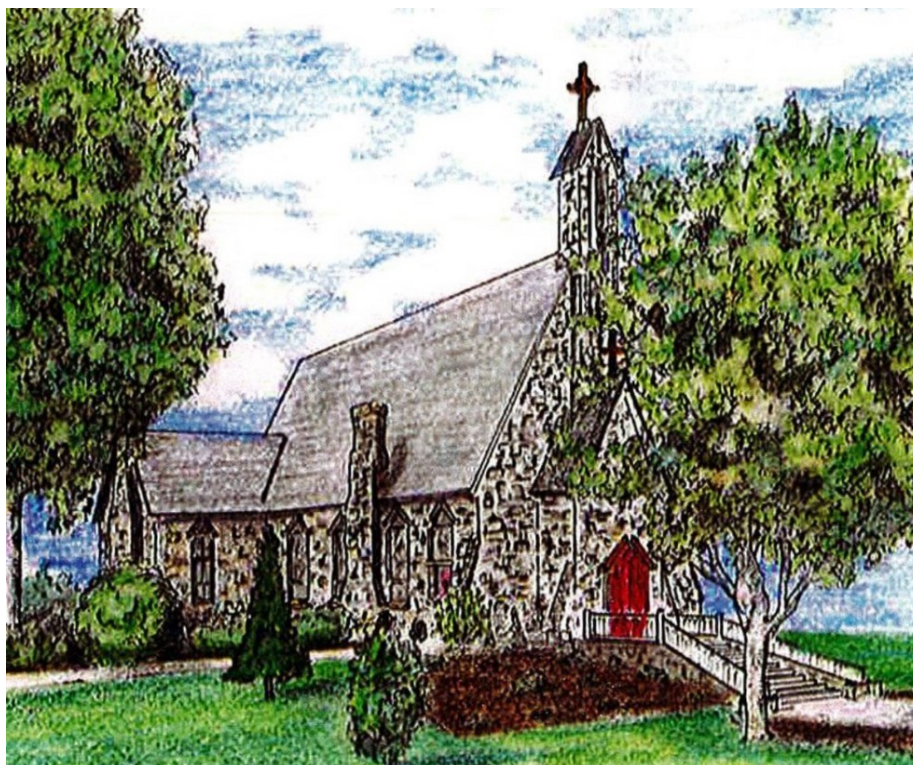

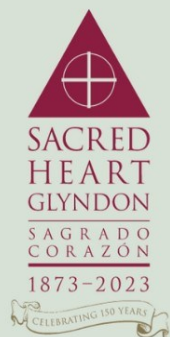
