My name is John W. Keeley and I am very proud to say that I am the principal at Sacred Heart School. Fr. Jerry has been gracious in allowing me to write this letter to you. Starting January 28, we will begin a long tradition in Catholic education known as Catholic Schools Week (CSW). During Catholic Schools Week, we celebrate our school and faith in so many ways with activities and events. The first being our Open House to be held right after the 11:30 AM Mass this Sunday.

We would like to invite you to visit our school and meet our faculty, staff, and administration. We would love for you to see our school and classrooms, visit our updated library, speak with teachers, and school families. We are so very proud of our school and if you are looking for a child centered school that teaches the Gospel of Jesus Christ, then Sacred Heart School is your school of destination. **Now, more than ever, the world needs what Catholic schools have to offer.**

We are proud that Sacred Heart School has averaged 17.5% higher than the Archdiocese of Baltimore school scores on their High School Proficiency Test (HSPT). Our enrollment has risen to 465 current students, a 5% increase in the last two years. We offer multiple after school clubs; an 11:1 student-teacher ratio and an average class size of 22. We are extremely proud of the number of our middle school students who are members of the National Junior Honor Society. Technology plays an important role in the education of our students with Chromebooks, interactive white boards, 3D pens and printers used across the curriculum.

Our students practice their faith by attending Mass every week. Giving back to others is also an important part of our Catholic identity and celebrating our students, our faculty/staff, our families, and community. If you are looking for a safe, loving environment that teaches our children values, respect and that all children are children of God, please join us this Sunday right after the 11:30 AM Mass. Please note that each contribution is recorded on the day it was received, not on the date on the envelope.

- Go to our parish website www.shgparish.org
- Click on the **Giving** tab on the right side.
- Click on My Contribution Statement
- If this is your first time logging in, click on Don't have an account?
 Sign up
- Enter your email address and/or mobile telephone number that you have on record with the parish.
- You will be asked to finish the account set-up process using a 2-factor authentication process to set up a password.
- Once this is done, go to next step.
- Log in by entering your email address and/or mobile telephone number and your password.
- Make sure the gray button that says 2023 is highlighted.
- Click on the blue **Save as PDF** button.
- Your contribution statement will appear, make sure you save the pdf file to your computer!
- Please make sure to save your password for future use.




