FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

New Beginnings! We celebrate them on New Year's Day, on birthdays, at weddings and other celebrations where we can see and experience a new start in life. Though we may not think of it in this way, Lent offers us new beginnings. We hear it in the first reading from the Book of Genesis. The flood is over. Evil has been vanquished. God has literally washed the earth and all wickedness is removed. He now makes a covenant with Noah and his descendants symbolized by the appearance of a rainbow in the sky. God vows that He will never again destroy the earth through a flood and that He will not only be with Noah, but with his descendants forever.

Jesus announces a new beginning in the Gospel with the words, "Repent, and believe in the Gospel." They are one set of the words the priest/deacon/minister may use as he puts ashes on our heads on Ash Wednesday. They are a call to action, to a new beginning. Don't stay where you are. Look at the negative, the imperfect and the ugly in your life and let God wash it away as He did in the flood or at our own baptism.

As we accompany our more than 40 candidates and catechumen who will be baptized, confirmed, and receive the Eucharist at Easter time, let us remember our own baptism. Our parents cared enough to bring us to church and let God wash us and make us members of the church. Instead of taking this for granted, we renew the promises of our baptism during these 40 days of Lent. We should be different when Easter arrives.
