FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

In the Book of Exodus, as we recently heard at Sunday Mass, God writes His Ten Commandments on stone and, of course, Moses breaks them when he witnesses the disobedience and idolatry of the people who are worshipping a golden calf. Today, in the Book of the Prophet Jeremiah, God pledges, instead, to write the law on their hearts. It is a very touching image. Stone is cold and hard and dead. But our hearts are living and active and the symbol of love. God wants us to listen to His commandments and live them, not out of obligation or fear, but out of love.

Jesus, in a similar way in the Gospel, talks about loving so much that we would lay down our life like a grain of wheat. But we don't do it for a worthless cause or for politics or self-gain; we lay down our life so that it may produce fruit. That is the whole symbol of prostration that we witness at an ordination or a final profession of a Sister – they lay down on the sanctuary, giving their whole life to God for the sake of the Gospel.

All of us are asked to sacrifice so that the Gospel may spread each day. Coming to Church fulfills that command of loving God but it also gives us the input, the energy, the solidarity with others and the inspiration to go forth throughout the week and do the right thing.

We are quickly approaching Passion (Palm) Sunday next weekend and then Holy Week. What in us needs to die–jealousy, talking about people, cynicism or negativity, consumerism---in order for us to really enter, with Jesus, into His laying down of His life so that He and we may take it up again with great fruit?
