FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

How well do we know the scriptures? In the past, before Vatican II, Catholics were actually told not to read the Bible because the church feared they would misinterpret it. This fear was well-founded based on the errors of the Reformation and those who broke away from the church, believing in things like sola scriptura, scripture alone, and a fundamentalist view of each word of the Bible. But we are now 60 years after Vatican II and we have been encouraged, as Catholics, to read and study the Bible.

In many of the appearances, Jesus explains to the disciples how he has fulfilled the scriptures. They would have known the Hebrew scriptures very well, yet they still did not understand how the resurrection of the Messiah, Jesus, fit perfectly with all of the prophecies and all of the writings of the Old Testament. Once again, in today's gospel, Jesus says, "Everything written about me in the law of Moses and the prophets and psalms must be fulfilled."

St. Jerome is famous for saying, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Jesus." We have no excuse. We need to read, study, and pray with the scriptures so that we understand Jesus and our faith better.

Pastoral Outreach

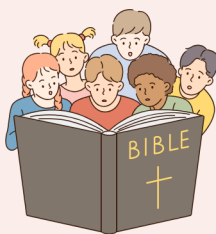
If you or someone you know cannot attend Mass in-person, we have a ministry to visit the sick or homebound and to bring them communion.
