

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

Our community will be celebrating the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, in a big way this weekend. First, a big thank you to all who contributed to decorating the "rugs" on which we process after the 4:00 PM Saturday Mass and all of those who set up altars for places of prayer. The enthusiasm and talent of this parish is so visible in this celebration. Hopefully, this Feast will remind us of the extraordinary gift Jesus gave us in the Eucharist – His very self. After all, if we want to stay close to someone after we have gone, we usually leave them with a note, a gift or some kind of remembrance, perhaps a picture, to keep them close to us and connected with us. Jesus does that in an extraordinary way by making the ordinary bread and ordinary wine, His very Body and Blood, to stay connected with us and to dwell within us. Because we celebrate Mass daily and we come to Mass on the weekends we can tend to forget the great gift we are given. It could become too commonplace. We even see it, sometimes, in the way people receive the Eucharist.

As we celebrate this Feast, this great gift, let us renew our commitment to Jesus, to His Body and Blood and to our reverence of the Sacrament as we receive it in Holy Communion and as we adore it in Adoration.
