FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Adam and Eve broke their relationship with God by disobeying. They had been given everything possible to make their life a literal paradise. They were simply told to refrain from eating from the tree in the middle of the garden. But, not being able to control themselves, they wanted what could not be theirs, and destroyed all of the blessings that had been bestowed upon them. The greatest destruction was in their relationship with God.

Jesus comes to restore that relationship. We hear it in the gospel reading when he includes not just Mary and other people outside the house, but all people, all of us, as his brothers and sisters. Everything Jesus did was to repair the breach. He repaired the breach with God and with one another.

We can learn tremendously from Jesus. Where we have broken relationships with other people and with God, we can now repair them in a spirit of love, forgiveness, and a desire for unity.

Did you know that the entire Universal Church is in a process of renewal called Synodality? What is the Synod on Synodality?

The Synod on Synodality, initiated by Pope Francis in October 2021, is a multiyear, worldwide undertaking of the universal Church focusing on the question "What steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our 'journeying together' as a Church?"

The Catholic Church's massive synodal process had already undergone diocesan, national, and continental stages. It culminates in two global assemblies at the Vatican. The first just took place October 4-28, 2023, and the second will be in October 2024 to advise the Pope on the topic: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission."
