

FROM OUR NEW ASSOCIATE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I was ordained a priest two weekends ago through the laying on of hands by our Archbishop William Lori. It's been a life-changing event for me, for when one is ordained as a priest, he undergoes an **onto-logical change**. Ontological! That is a fancy word. It describes a change *in being* itself. After ordination, the priest might appear to be the same as he was before, but his essence, his very being, changes forever. In other words, I look the same to you, but my very being (essence) has changed, for now I am an "alter Christus" (another Christ). I was conformed to the Person of Jesus Christ as His priest. It is truly a miracle that happened when Archbishop Lori's hands touched my head, and he said the prayer of ordination.

Through the ordination ritual, one can see how God's touch can transform our lives. It seems like people in Jesus' time knew this very well, according to our Sunday Gospel. Jairus asked Jesus to lay His hands on his daughter who was dying. The woman with hemorrhage also knew that, by touching Jesus' clothes, she would recover. However, nothing would have changed in their lives, or in mine, if faith hadn't been present. God's transforming power can change anything and anybody. I am no longer Ángel, but Fr. Ángel, who acts "in Persona Christi."

So far, I haven't had the opportunity to administer the sacrament of the healing of the sick. I am very much looking forward to it. You could be the first person I visit to anoint, who knows? But what you should know is that it is **not** Ángel Acuña. It is Christ Who is touching you and healing you with the help of the Holy Spirit, supported through your faith at the hands of an ordained minister.

Did you know that the entire Universal Church is in a process of renewal called Synodality? Who can participate in the Synod?

Pope Francis has stressed on several occasions the need for the Synod to involve everyone, and to reach out as much as possible. "Everyone has a part to play; no one is a mere extra...The Synod is for everyone, and it is meant to include everyone...Let everyone come in...the Holy Spirit needs us. Listen to him by listening to each other. Leave no one behind or excluded."

He stressed, "real involvement on the part of each and all," and "a way of acting marked by true participation...Enabling everyone to participate is an essential ecclesial duty! All the baptized, for baptism is our identity card."

Because this way of proceeding is not the usual way the Church operates, Pope Francis is explicit in saying this involve a change or conversion. The Synod is about us, the people of God at Sacred Heart Parish and who we want to become as a Church. Be informed.
