#### **FROM THE PASTOR**

Dear Parishioners,

In the first reading this weekend, we hear Amos testify, "I was no prophet, nor have I belonged to a company of prophets; I was a shepherd and dresser of sycamores. The Lord took me from the flock." He is responding to the king who is tired of Amos making claims against him. Amos wants the king to know that he did not ask for this job. He was minding his own business when God called him forward to be a prophet.

In the gospel, we hear the apostles amazed because they, common ordinary men, are able to perform the work of Christ. They drive out demons and cure people. Yet they were not from any special class or profession.

It is clear, in the readings this weekend, that God calls forward the people He wants, not necessarily the people who are qualified or trained. We often think that we cannot do the work of the Lord because we do not have the theology, the background or the experience. Jesus called simple fisherman to be the foundation of his ministry and church. There is an old saying, "God does not call the qualified; he qualifies the called." If you are feeling the desire in your heart to serve the Lord, forget about qualifications. They will come. Instead, ask God how He wants you to serve Him.
