Dear Parishioners,

"I want to see."

How many times have we said that to God or to someone else? I am foggy. I am unclear. I am wandering. Show me the way. That's the cry of so many people these days and it's the cry of Bartimaeus in the Gospel 2,000 years ago. He wants to see. He is blind. But he is physically blind! He literally can't see! So, while he may be desiring physical healing, he also is a great symbol for spiritual and emotional healing as well.

When that happens, an even greater challenge is given to him – he is asked to follow Jesus. While we might see that as very attractive, for him, it is a game changer. He leaves the life of a beggar to take on the role of a disciple. When we ask for sight, we have to be prepared for the change it also requires.


### **Anointing of the Sick**
