FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This Christmas Eve, Pope Francis will open the Holy Door at St. Peter's in Rome to inaugurate a Holy Year, a Jubilee of Hope. The theme of this special year of grace comes from Romans chapter 5, verse 5: *"Hope does not disappoint because the love of God has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit. ..."* That is the spirit of Christmas – hope!

Yet our world is mired in war – Sudan, Ukraine, Israel, Lebanon and the Gaza strip. In the very place where Jesus was born, people are starving, smallpox is threatening and people still hate one another. Is there really any hope for them or our world?

Well, if we take the secular view, no! There is no hope. Politicians and leaders and dictators are in their positions for themselves. Many large corporations and wealthy people do what is best for the bottom line, not considering the millions around the world who are affected by the lack of food, clean water or climate change. Many in our country have lost their faith and celebrate nothing this Christmas but a tree and gifts. Where is the hope?

The hope is in Jesus, the little one born in the manger this Christmas time. If we truly believe in Him, if we truly believe He is the Son of God, the one who has come into the world, then we have hope. Jesus did not come to a perfect world. Jesus did not wait until all of the conditions were right according to human history. No, the miracle of Christmas is that Christ entered our human history and came to live among us precisely to give hope to the hopeless, light to those in darkness and peace to those who dwell in turmoil.

If you truly believe in Jesus, then come to worship Him weekly. Don't let Christmas be the rare time that you think about God and church and Jesus. We offer hope every day as we celebrate the meal He left us – the Eucharist. We offer hope every day as we visit the sick, the elderly and the homebound. We offer hope each week as we study the Bible, form our children in the love of Jesus and tell them of the beauty of the world. Be part of this community, an active part of this community, every week! I guarantee you will find hope even in the midst of the despair of this world.

DEL PASTOR

Queridos feligreses,

Esta Nochebuena, el Papa Francisco abrirá la Puerta Santa de San Pedro en Roma para inaugurar un Año Santo, un Jubileo de la Esperanza. El tema de este año especial de gracia viene de Romanos capítulo 5, versículo 5: "La esperanza no defrauda, porque el amor de Dios ha sido derramado en nuestros corazones por medio del Espíritu Santo. ..." Ese es el espíritu de la Navidad: ¡esperanza!

Sin embargo, nuestro mundo está sumido en la guerra: Sudán, Ucrania, Israel, Líbano y la Franja de Gaza. En el mismo lugar donde nació Jesús, la gente se muere de hambre, la viruela amenaza y la gente todavía se odia entre sí. ¿Hay realmente alguna esperanza para ellos o para nuestro mundo?

Bueno, si adoptamos el punto de vista secular, ¡no! No hay esperanza. Los políticos, los líderes y los dictadores están en sus puestos por sí mismos. Muchas grandes corporaciones y personas adineradas hacen lo que es mejor para el resultado final, sin considerar a los millones de personas en todo el mundo que se ven afectadas por la falta de alimentos, agua potable o el cambio climático. Muchos en nuestro país han perdido su fe y no celebran nada esta Navidad más que un árbol y regalos. ¿Dónde está la esperanza?

La esperanza está en Jesús, el pequeño que nacerá en su pesebre en este tiempo de Navidad. Si realmente creemos en Él, si realmente creemos que Él es el Hijo de Dios, el que ha venido al mundo, entonces tenemos esperanza. Jesús no vino a un mundo perfecto. Jesús no esperó hasta que todas las condiciones fueran las correctas de acuerdo con la historia humana. No, el milagro de la Navidad es que Cristo entró en nuestra historia humana y vino a vivir entre nosotros precisamente para dar esperanza a los desesperados, luz a los que están en tinieblas y paz a los que viven en la confusión.

Si realmente crees en Jesús, entonces ven a adorarlo semanalmente. No dejes que la Navidad sea el raro momento en que pienses en Dios, en la iglesia y en Jesús. Ofrecemos esperanza todos los días mientras celebramos la comida que Él nos dejó: la Eucaristía. Ofrecemos esperanza todos los días mientras visitamos a los enfermos, los ancianos y los confinados en sus hogares. Ofrecemos esperanza cada semana mientras estudiamos la Biblia, formamos a nuestros hijos en el amor de Jesús y les hablamos de la belleza del mundo. ¡Sé parte de esta comunidad, una parte activa de esta comunidad, todas las semanas! Te garantizo que encontrarás esperanza incluso en medio de la desesperación de este mundo.

¡Feliz Navidad y que la Paz del Niño Jesús esté con ustedes!

The 2025 Jubilee will be celebrated from 24 December 2024 to 6 January 2026 and will represent a moment of great importance for millions of faithful around the world.



The Jubilee Logo: The logo shows four stylized figures, representing all of humanity, coming from the four corners of the earth. They embrace each other to indicate the solidarity and fraternity which should unite all peoples. The figure at the front is holding onto the cross. It is not only the sign of the faith which this lead figure embraces, but also of hope, which can never be abandoned, because we are always in need of hope, especially in our moments of greatest need.

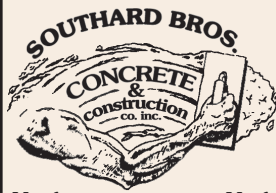
