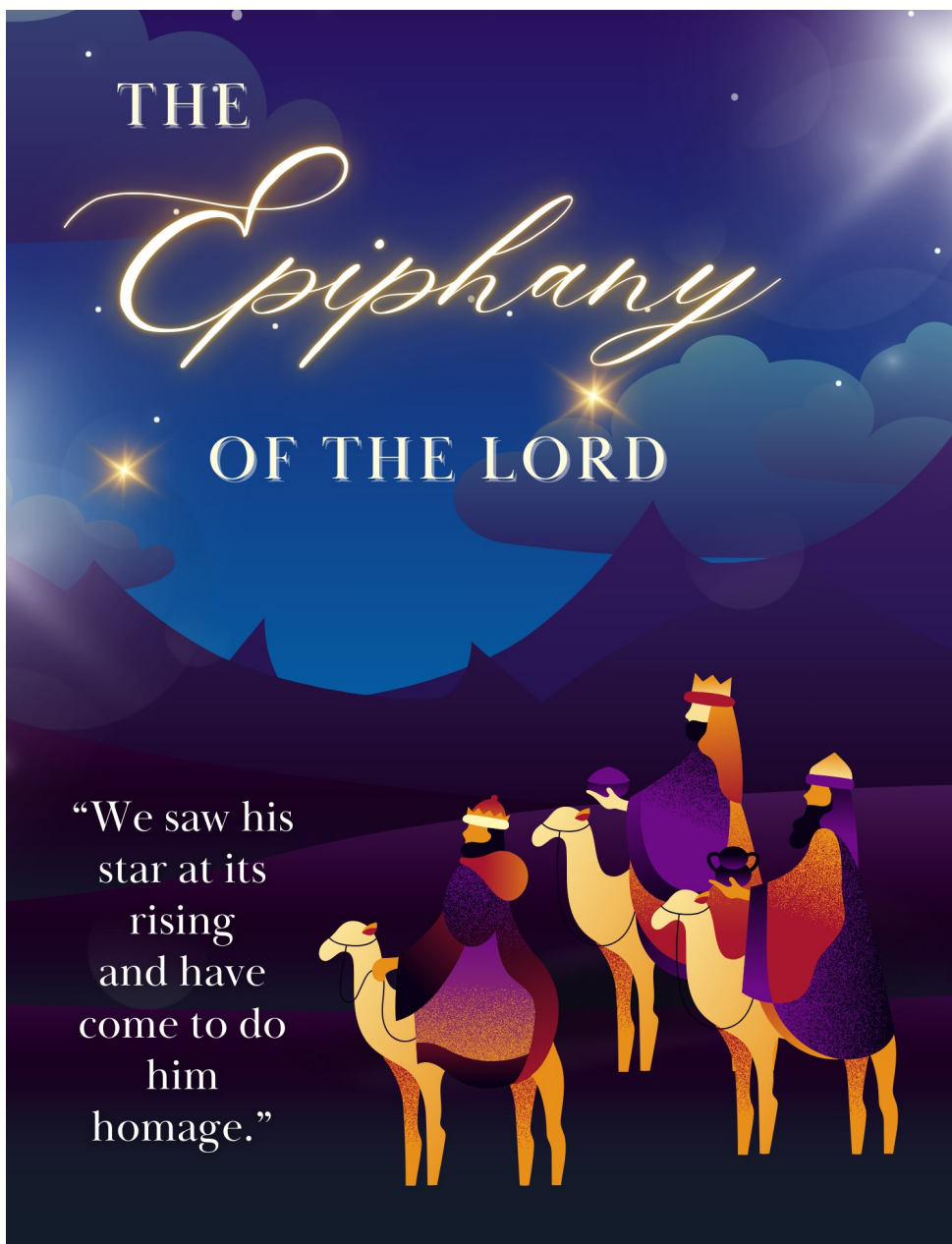

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

***"See, darkness covers the earth, and
thick clouds cover the peoples"***

That is how Isaiah begins his prophecy today for the Feast of the Epiphany. He sees what is going on all around him and in the world, and it is chaos. Yet Isaiah sees a bright future for his people and his nation. The shock is that he not only sees this future for his nation, Israel, but for many nations from afar, gentiles who don't even believe in the one God of the Jewish faith. "Midian and Ephah; all from Sheba shall come." In Isaiah's day, these words would have been flabbergasting! Israel expected a bright future for themselves and a savior to come. But they did not anticipate the savior would be for the entire world.

Today, with the Feast of the Epiphany, God casts his net wide. The Three Kings and Matthew's Gospel represent salvation opening for the entire world. Matthew is writing to a Jewish audience so he wants them to hear very clearly that they are not the only lucky ones. Jesus came for all.

When we get narrowminded or singularly focused, Epiphany is a great Feast for us to celebrate. It reminds us that God is so much bigger than our hopes and expectations, our limits and Laws. Epiphany invites us to open our minds.

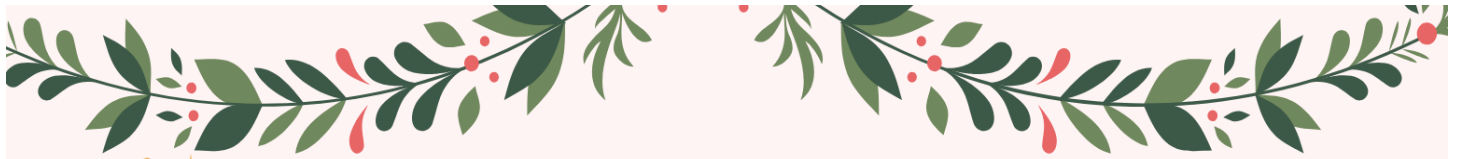

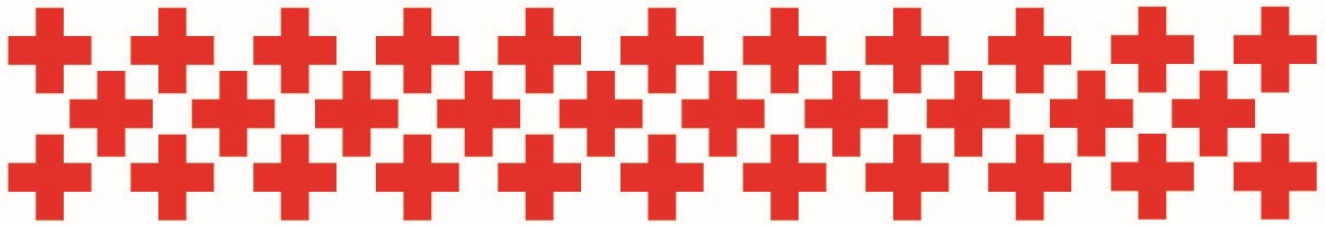

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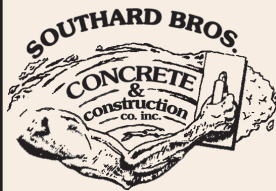
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
