Protecting God's Children

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called **Prevent and Protect STL**.

Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are **REQUIRED** and **ASKED** to register in the new system as soon as possible. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct.

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER KAVANAGH

A large part of the discouragement we can experience regarding Lent can stem from our over-complicating it. Think back to Ash Wednesday, it's the beginning of a new liturgical season, and much like new year's, we usually adopt some sort of resolution (or we resolve to give up something for Lent); and like new year's resolutions, many of these high hopes may not last very long. We may say "I want to pray more this Lent", or "I'm giving up chocolate"; but as the season goes on we may find ourselves falling short of our goal. I encourage us all to not be discouraged, don't throw in the towel this Lent! This season is not some type of competition. If we fail to "pray everyday", or if we mistakenly "eat a piece of chocolate" because we completely forgot that we had pledged to give that up, then let's not beat ourselves up - but let us draw upon the strength we receive through God's grace and continue on our Lenten plan.

Along with whatever we choose to fast from during this Lenten season, you can also try adding something spiritual as well. Two great things to try to add into your faith life this Lent would be to try to make it to daily Mass, even just once; and to also receive God's forgiveness and healing in confession.

Also, we will be having a morning of prayer and reflection on the topic of suffering. This will begin with a prayerful reflection, and continue with some time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament in Adoration, and conclude with one more reflection. This will take place on Saturday, March 14th, beginning at 9:30 a.m. and will conclude by 11 a.m. Please consider attending this opportunity to grow deeper in the understanding in the Church's teachings regarding suffering in our lives and how to approach it with faith.

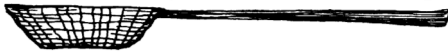
