The Archdiocese of St Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. **Everyone** ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are **required and asked** to register in the new system as soon as possible. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop all clergy, volunteers and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. FROM THE DESK OF FATHER KAVANAGH

Hey everyone! I hope that you are all doing well! As you know spring is usually the time of year when we celebrate many of the great sacraments together in our church such as First Communion, Confirmation, and the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults entering the church; but as with everything else, this spring has been anything but normal. I'm sure many of you have been at a Mass over the past month where a young person of our parish received one of these sacraments, and we as a parish family are so proud of our young people as they grow deeper in their faith!

On June 28th at the 11 a.m. Mass, Toni Jodlowski, an adult member of our parish and the Catholic Deaf community, made her Profession of Faith, received her First Communion, and was Confirmed as well! We are excited to welcome Toni as a full member of the Catholic Church! Toni has been learning more about all of the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church over the past year in preparation for entering the Church. Some of you may be familiar with RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults), but some may be reading that name here for the first time. The Catholic Church has a period of preparation and study for those adults, who growing up in other faiths or maybe no faith, wish to be a full member of the Body of Christ in the Catholic Church. Some parishes structure their RCIA program around a classroom environment, but one of the blessings of being a small parish, is that we can adapt how we learn about our faith to a smaller audience. If you are interested in learning more about this process, either for yourself or someone you know, please feel free to reach out to me. Working with RCIA programs during my priesthood has been such an awesome experience, and I would be happy to talk more about the process with you! Let us continue to pray as a parish family for all of those who are thinking of entering the RCIA process, that their hearts may always be open to listening to God calling them to Himself.

Finally, just a reminder that I have been, and will continue to send email updates regarding COVID-19 Guidelines for the parish that I receive from the Archdiocese. Since these guidelines are very fluid and can change without much notice, it's best to communicate these quickly via email rather than in the bulletin due to the time lag between my writing these articles and when the bulletin is printed. 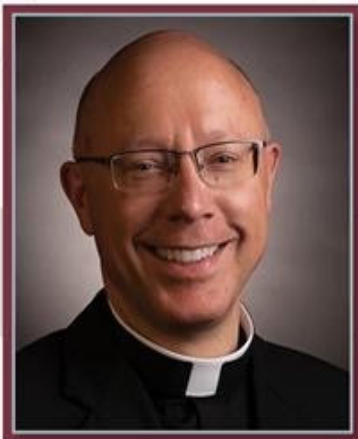
SOULCORE
