Pastor's Corner

It's been said that some of the Ancient Jewish Rabbis made sure that a small child (7 or 8 years old) was present during their teachings. The Rabbi would stop, from time to time, and turn to the child. "Did you understand what I just said?" The child might respond, "No, Rabbi." So, on those occasions, the Rabbi would present the lesson again in *more simple terms*. The students/men in attendance would *nod in approval*. Not that they thought the Rabbi was performing an endearing effort (by including this child). It was coupled with the fact that they too, didn't understand and were too embarrassed to say anything. *God bless the child*. Because of the presence of the child, ALL could understand the Rabbinical sayings and teachings.

So, it is with the teaching of our faith.

Some Catholic adults are convinced that one's faith is measured by memorization of prayers, gestures, rituals, or responses at Mass. Some priests will stop a liturgy and publicly scold the children for not knowing their prayers. No, no, no. Faith is measured by how much we become like Jesus Christ. Some are convinced that "If children/teens fail at these practices, they are ignorant, badly disciplined, disrespectful and obviously do not love God or Jesus."

I was so blessed by wonderful Catholic parents. They did not shove religion down my throat, threaten or make me feel guilty. Dad didn't force me to go to Mass. He "invited" me. I loved and looked forward to going to Mass to be with all of those wonderful loving people. Consequently, I learned the prayers, gestures and responses not because **I had to**, but because it was the good thing to do. I saw good, loving, consistent, authentic people doing these things. *I wanted to be part of that*. I was motivated to participate in those things, too. If you want God and Jesus to be a priority in their lives, He must be a priority in yours.

When I was a child, I was also told that when I do these things well (prayer, sincere gestures, rituals, Sacraments) I am guaranteed God's life (Grace) and it will assist me in the struggles of earthly life. Oh yes, I will do these things. I want to do these things. I love to do these things. God's love will come alive in these practices.

Children know when someone is authentic or phony. They see hypocrisy and can distinguish between sincerity and "people going through the motions". There is nothing more effective than for a child to see the love of God and Jesus actually practiced in a devout Catholic.

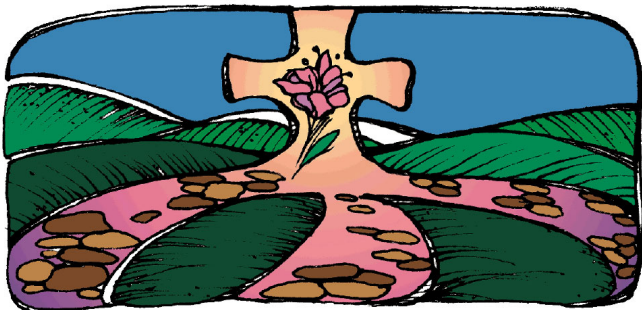

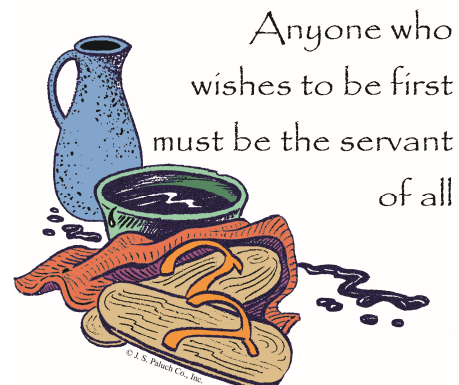

Today's first two readings present a striking contrast between two pathways in life. In Wisdom and the letter from James we are told of the path of the wicked, which leads to oppression and violence. We also hear of the path of the faithful, which leads to peace and human flourishing. Then our Gospel reading from Mark takes our reflection farther. The choice is shown to be not so simple or obvious. The path of faithfulness means following Jesus' lead, to expand our circle of care toward everyone, especially the most vulnerable. This path also includes opening ourselves to suffering and trials, as we face resistance from within and from outside us. The two paths essentially diverge over whether we refuse or accept God's love. Each day we face such choices as God invites us into the divine circle of care and enlists us to extend our own circle to those around us.
