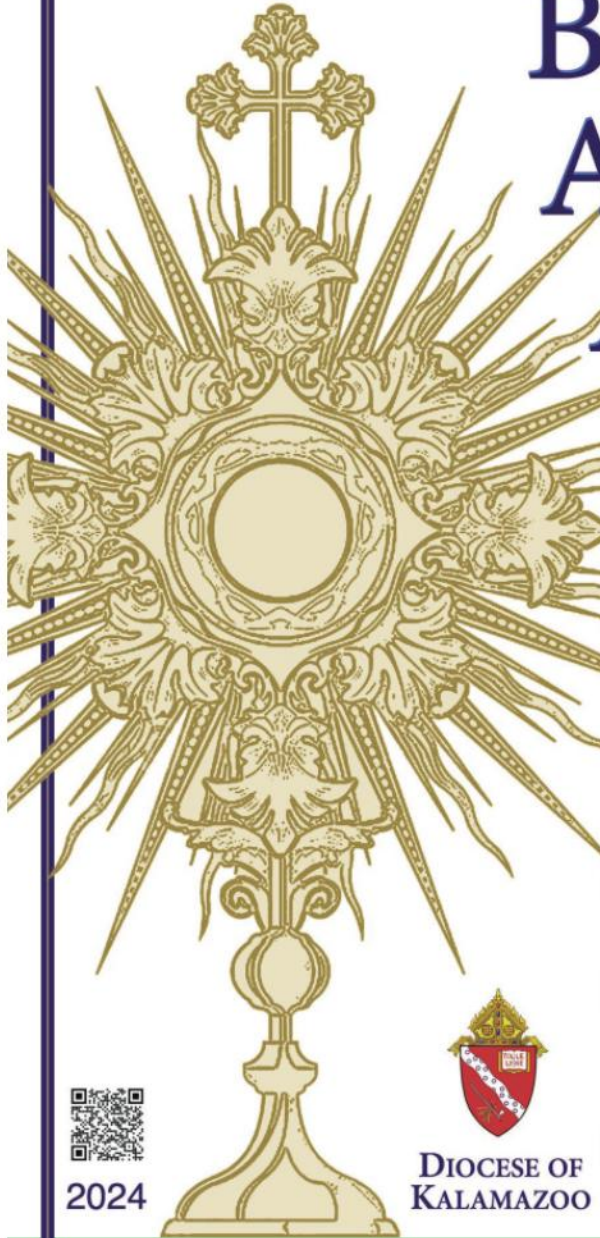

## **Ben Bowers' Journey to the Catholic Faith**



I was raised Baptist until the age of 15. My parents stopped going to the Baptist Church we attended in Southern California and I never went back to church until twelve years later in July of 2023 when I found myself walking into St. Mary's. Over those 12 years, I joined the Army as an infantryman, went to Afghanistan for one year, and graduated from University. I'm saddened to say a lot of these experiences drew me further from God and made me very bitter towards Him.

Looking back, I feel like a fool for blaming the atrocities of war on God or letting my fleshly desires in college pull me further away from Him.

For the last two years I felt a strong pull to get back to Church; however, I knew through my experiences of Protestantism that I simply could not go back to that. I began researching.. "What's the closest Christian denomination to Jesus?", "Who founded the Catholic Church?" Let me tell you once I found out Jesus founded the Catholic Church, the questions in my mind only got bigger and I began googling EVERYTHING from why Catholics adore Mary to the teachings on purgatory.

I joined the RCIA/OCIA and everything began to come into focus: Catholics aren't the "statue worshipping, Mary idolizing group" I had been led to believe. The Church embodies all of the sacraments Jesus founded and I became deeply moved. I must tell you, I also found deep sadness for my family and our Protestant brothers and sisters who have an aspect of the faith, but are truly missing out on the sacraments and the fullness of faith. Every sacrament is a deeply rewarding and moving experience that I wish every man, woman and child partook in. I like to imagine when I was in my twelve years of worldly behaviors not believing or adhering to God that he was deeply saddened, but possibly he was also grinning saying, "hold on kid, I've got a wild twist coming your way!"

You all have been incredibly welcoming to not only me, but my wife, Ty, and our daughter, Lily, and I am beyond blessed to have been brought here through the absolute grace of our Lord!

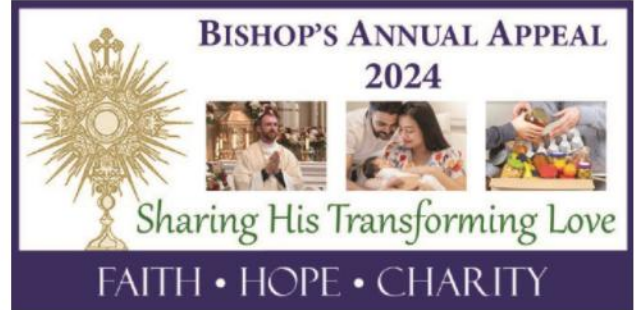
