Dear Parish Families,

As summer comes to a close, we are gearing up to begin our busier fall schedules, including religious education. I am excited to begin a new year of faith formation. We will continue to have our weekly classes for children ages 4-8th grade. Our religious education schedule will be as follows:

We will try and work with you to make religious education instruction work for you. **We will begin on Sunday, September 22 for the Sunday groups and Tuesday, September 24 for the Tuesday groups.**
