Sharing Our Faith Stories

Welcome to the Solis-Mullen Family! Joseph & Alexandria, Luca, Cash, Milena, Adalaine, & Gus

We are the Solis-Mullen family - Joseph and Alexandria, and our five children: Luca (17), Cash (13), Milena (9), Adalaine (7), and Gus (4). We live a joyfully full life raising children, homeschooling, wrangling too many pets (a dog, two cats, a duck, a turtle, a frog, and 12 chickens), and exploring the world when we can. Joseph is a professor of history and political science at Spring Arbor University, and Alexandria is an attorney. Our lives are loud, busy, and often chaotic—but also rich in love and growing faith.

Joseph was raised Catholic, and Alexandria was raised in a deeply committed Protestant home, but as a young adult, stepped away from faith after wrestling with difficult theological inconsistencies. For many years, we felt something was missing—not just for us as individuals, but in our family life. We both felt the growing pull to place God at the center of our home.

At first, Alexandria wanted to attend Mass out of curiosity. Alexandria had always felt a cultural connection to the Catholic faith through her Mexican and Italian heritage and wanted to understand what had been absent in her spiritual upbringing. But what started as a curiosity became a calling. The more we learned, the more deeply we felt drawn in - by the reverence, the beauty, and the peace, but most importantly, the truth that comes not from intellectual understanding, but from surrender.

Luca, our eldest, surprised us when he asked to join the adult OCIA class with Mom, while still in high school. Going through the process together was transformational. The friendships we formed, the spiritual formation we received, and the gentle guidance of Carol DiBiaggio all meant more than words can say. We grew together—not just in knowledge, but in faith and peace. For Alexandria, it was a time of profound healing and deliverance. She began to understand what it means to experience the peace that surpasses all understanding.

At the same time, our younger children began Catechism classes. Every week, we saw their excitement grow - their budding love for Jesus, their questions, their awe. We realized this wasn't just a chapter in our story - it was a rebirth of our entire family's spiritual life.

Our family was joyfully received into the Church this Easter. It is no exaggeration to say that we are not the same family we were two years ago. We are more grounded, more joyful, and more united in purpose and faith. We thank Fr. Craig for being a steady, compassionate, patient, and inspiring shepherd. We thank the Catechism teachers who helped form our children with so much love and patience. And we thank Carol and our other OCIA instructors and our OCIA community for walking with us and making us feel welcome and understood. Please know your work is truly saving souls.

One of our most cherished moments this year was our trip to attend an outdoor Mass in Castel Gandolfo, Italy celebrated by Pope Leo (see picture from that day). Standing there with our children, in the shadow of Church history, fully alive in our faith, was an unforgettable moment of grace and gratitude.

To those still journeying: ask your questions, follow the pull in your heart, and know that God's timing is perfect. We are so thankful to be home. In God's love, The Solis-Mullen Family
