Ezekiel pictures God as the good shepherd who looks after the flock and protects the sheep from harm.

**Second Reading, 1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 28**

Paul celebrates the Lord's victory over sin and death. Jesus is the new Adam.

**Gospel, Matthew 25:31-46**

Jesus, seen as the son of man, renders final judgment on all nations by separating people into the categories of sheep who are saved and goats who are accursed.

*Psalm Response for this week*

The Lord is my shepherd;  
there is nothing I shall want.

Our response reminds us that Jesus is always with us, guiding us even when we feel lost.

*This week in Focus*

OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE we live in a "humpty-dumpty world," a broken world. Millions slaughtered by their own kind, mass migration of refugees across the globe, disease ravaging continents, and the ever-widening gap between the rich and the poor are some signs of the cruel joke. "All the king's men" – the kings of science, technology, economics, politics, and even religion – "could not put Humpty together again."

There is only one King who can bring fulfillment, and that is Christ the King, raised from the dead. He will rescue his sheep from all the places where they have been scattered: by disease, starvation, war, and oppressive authority. Those baptized into the life and death of Christ are called to kingship with Jesus the Good Shepherd who seeks to rescue the lost sheep.

We are called to be kings of a "humpty-dumpty" world. We are the King's men and women putting Humpty together again, restoring life not as the kings and queens of illusion would have it, but as Christ the King would have it. "Whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me." Let us renew our commitment to respond with care and compassion to those around us and work for a more just world.

*SOLEMNITY of Our Lord Jesus Christ,  
King of the Universe*

The feast of "Christ the King" was first established in 1925, and Pope Saint Paul VI expanded its name to "King of the Universe" in 1969. Jesus is not just a King of Hearts. He is more than a Universal Coach, Teacher, or Consoler of mankind. By "King of the Universe" the Church is communicating Jesus' metaphysical scale, that God encompasses all of reality, not just man's reality. We say in the Nicene Creed that God created all things visible and invisible. So Jesus is King over all the planets, stars, black holes, quasars, and exploding suns in the blackest corners of remote space. He is King over the earth and all its waterfalls, rainforests, mountain peaks, desert plains, and dark sea floors. He lords over all creation because He is its source. Saint Thomas Aquinas taught correctly when he wrote that God is not the most perfect being inside of creation but Being itself. God is reality, not just the most impressive being inhabiting the reality bubble.
