LENTEN SEASON **ASH WEDNESDAY**

Ash Wednesday is the beginning of a new season in the Church's year and it is an invitation for us to begin a new season in our lives. Lent is a time for us to acknowledge both that we are sinners and that we are saved through God's abundant love. On Ash Wednesday, let the ashes on our forehead proclaim our dependence on the God who made us, and who also invites us to renew our lives this Lent through prayer, fasting and almsgiving, so that on Easter we may rise with Jesus the Lord to New Life.

Every Friday, during Lent, Stations of the Cross will be held beginning at 6:15 p.m. followed by the regular scheduled Mass at 7:00 p.m.

Ash Wednesday, First Day of Lent

The start of the forty days of Lent is a practice run. One day, we will all have to give an accounting of our lives. The balance sheet will have to be settled, the good and the bad weighed in their columns. Ash Wednesday is a reminder of something we know but don't call to mind often enough. Without God all that remains of our greatness is a little pile of dust. We are, in a sense, marked with ourselves today. The tiny black crumbs of ash will fall away in a matter of hours, to be forgotten for another year. And life will go on. Such is our destiny. With God, everything. Without God, nothing.
