They didn't understand that the man who was asking them to give up everything in their lives and follow him was none other than the Son of God.

How many times have we responded to God in the same way? God is calling us, but we don't always realize it. We may already have plans, important things we want to do, and although we hear the call, we do not make following it a priority.

However, no matter how many times we've delayed responding to God's call, the invitation still stands. And even though we've gone our own way, Christ finds us where we are and requests our company on his mission.

Being a disciple of Christ is not easy. It implies a leap of faith. It requires us to freely choose, every single day, to live for something greater than ourselves.



He is perhaps a more striking example of the simple fact of holiness. Jesus says to us as he said, in effect, to Peter: "It is not you who have chosen me, but I who have chosen you. Peter, it is not human wisdom that makes it possible for you to believe, but my Father's revelation. I, not you, build my Church." Paul's experience of the risen Jesus on the road to Damascus was the driving force that made him one of the most zealous, dynamic, and courageous ambassadors of Christ the Church has ever had. But persecution, humiliation, and weakness became his day-by-day carrying of the cross, material for further transformation. The dying Christ was in him; the living Christ was his life.
