DID YOU KNOW?

Why does it help to communicate your concerns? If you have concerns about someone's behavior, sharing those concerns is critical to protecting the children in that person's life. Communicating your concerns, and having them investigated, can also discourage a potential offender, pushing them to leave the program or stop their behaviors.
