

8th Annual Bayou Teche Eucharistic Boat Procession

Come celebrate the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary at St. Joseph Church on Monday, August 15th. The procession begins at 8 a.m. with Mass in French celebrated by Bishop Deshotel at St. Leo the Great Catholic church in Leonville. At 9:30 a.m. boats will depart in procession down Bayou Teche toward St. Martinville, retracing the voyage made by the Acadians over 250 years ago. The boat procession will stop for rosary and benediction at churches in towns along the route. The first stop will be at St. Francis Regis at 10:20 a.m., St. Joseph Church in Cecilia at 11:45 a.m., St. Bernard church in Breaux Bridge at 1:35 p.m., St. Joseph church in Parks at 3:15 p.m., Notre Dame church in St. Martinville at 4:45 p.m. Upon arriving in St. Martinville, a foot procession will commence to Notre Dame de Perpetual Secours for Benediction, then to St. Martin de Tours for Benediction, and finally down Main Street to Mater Dolorosa Chapel Solemn Vespers and Final Benediction at 6 p.m. Confessions will be heard in mobile units at each of the stops along the way.
